Next, you will proceed to [El-Deir El-Bahari](#), a stunning temple constructed by Queen Hatshepsut, who was one of the most remarkable and influential pharaohs of ancient Egypt. She reigned during the 18th Dynasty, around 1478-1458 BCE. What sets Hatshepsut apart from other pharaohs is that she was a female ruler in a predominantly male-dominated society.

Another highlight of the tour is the [Colossi of Memnon](#), two massive stone statues of Pharaoh Amenhotep III. These statues stand at the front of the partially ruined Mortuary Temple of Amenhotep III, which was once the largest temple in the Theban Necropolis.

As an optional activity, you may choose to embark on a hot air balloon ride, providing a breathtaking aerial view of Luxor. Witness the mesmerizing temples, including the iconic Statue of Thebes, illuminated by the early morning sun.
