Itinerary

Day 1: Welcome to Luxor Tour - Nile Cruise.

Our representative will pick you up at the airport or Luxor train station in a private air-conditioned vehicle and take you to your Nile cruise. taking off. Explore the largest temple complex in human history, the Karnak temple complex, as part of an afternoon trip along Luxor's east bank. The temple of Amun Re, which was thought to be God's dwelling on Earth, is the principal building. Since God Amen was the most revered deity in Thebes during the New Kingdom, the ancient Egyptians wished to pay tribute to him by erecting temples.

Although there are sporadic allusions to earlier 3rd Dynasty buildings, the earliest buildings are from the Middle Kingdom.

You will later visit <u>the Luxor Temple</u>, which was completed by the renowned pharaoh <u>Ramses II</u> and begun by one of the 12th dynasty's rulers. Similar to Karnak, this temple was situated in the center of the city and was devoted to Amun Re, the principal deity of ancient Thebes. You will be taken to your boat to rest and refuel after your day excursion. The staff will put on an Egyptian folklore show in the evening. Dinner will be served, and then you'll spend the night in Luxor.

Day 2: Luxor West Bank Tour.

The cruise along the Nile includes breakfast. After that, you'll start your incredible journey to Thebes, the holiest place in Egypt, by touring the west bank of Luxor, which includes the Valley of the Kings, which is thought to be the royal tomb of the Theban kings and rulers of old Egypt in addition to the tombs of our pharaohs. After that, you'll visit Queen Hatshepsut's temple in Deir El Bahari. One of the most remarkable architectural creations from ancient Egypt is thought to be this temple. A visit to King Amenhotep III's Colossi of Memnon will mark the conclusion of the expedition.

Day 3: Nile Cruise Tour (Edfu Temple)

The Nile cruise begins with breakfast and a tour of <u>the Temple of Horus at Edfu</u>. Lunch is served on board, followed by a visit to <u>Kom Ombo</u>, where Sobek and Haroeris were worshipped. Dinner is served on board, and the sun deck offers a view of the Nile's unique environment. The cruise ends with a night in Aswan.

Day 4 : Aswan Day Tour.

Onboard the ship, breakfast is provided. Your tour guide takes you to Aswan to see the incomplete obelisk, <u>the Temple of Philae</u>, and the <u>High Dam</u>. Lunch and tea are served on board following an adventure. You'll spend the night in Aswan and have the evening free for activities.

Day 5: trip to Abu Simble - Home.

Our English-speaking tour guide will drive you to <u>Abu Simbel</u>, a site of ancient Egyptian temples built by Ramses II. The Great Temple, dedicated to Rahorakhty, is the largest, while the smaller temple honors King Ramses II and Queen Nefertari. After an adventure, you'll return to Aswan and transfer to your hotel or Cairo

airport.
