Day 1: Karnak and Luxor Temples - Embarkation

Our Cairo Top Tours representative will pick you up at [Luxor airport](#) or train station for an Egypt Nile cruise tour. Visit [the Luxor temple](#), built during the New Kingdom by two pharaohs, [Amenhotep III](#) and Ramses II. Visit [the Karnak temple](#), an influential religious center in Ancient Egypt. Board the cruise ship in a private air-conditioned tourist car, enjoy lunch, dinner, and overnight stay.

Meals: Lunch, Dinner

Day 2: Valley of the Kings - Deir El Bahari - Colossi of Memnon

On a Nile River cruise, visit [the Valley of the Kings](#), where pharaohs were buried during the New Kingdom. Visit [the Temple of Hatshepsut](#), the unique 18th Dynasty temple. Explore [the Colossi of Memnon](#), two massive statues of pharaoh Amenhotep III. Sail to Edfu, dinner, and overnight.

Meals: Breakfast, lunch, dinner.

Day 3: Edfu and Kom Ombo Temples

Breakfast on board, followed by a horse-drawn carriage ride to the best-preserved [Horus temple](#) in Egypt. Lunch on board, then visit [the symmetrical Sobek temple](#) dedicated to Haroeris and Sobek, the local deity. Sail to Aswan, dinner, and overnight.

Meals: Breakfast, lunch, dinner.

Day 4: Aswan High Dam - Unfinished Obelisk - Temple of Philae - Falucca Ride

Onboard breakfast. Proceed to explore [the Aswan High Dam](#), constructed in 1960 to shield Egypt from the yearly flooding caused by the Nile.

Visit [the Unfinished Obelisk](#), a red granite monument attributed to [Queen Hatshepsut](#), the first woman in Egypt's history. Visit [Philae temple](#) dedicated to Isis, eleven kilometers from Aswan. Enjoy lunch on board. Take a felucca tour on the Nile. Dinner and overnight on board.

Meals: Breakfast, lunch, dinner.

Day 5: Disembarkation - Optional Abu Simbel Temples Tour
