Day 1 - Aswan City Tour

When you arrive in Aswan, our tour guide will be there to welcome you and take you to the Steam Ship Sudan Nile Cruise in an air-conditioned car.to unwind and take in the sun while dining al fresco on the deck. In the afternoon, you will travel past [Queen Hatshepsut's incomplete obelisk](#) and visit [the Aswan High Dam](#),

which was rebuilt on [Agilika Island](#) following the construction of the High Dam irrigation system. After that, you'll have time to explore the magnificent Greco-Roman [temple of Philae](#). Before dining on board, you can take a Felucca trip around Kitchener and explore the vibrant Nubian markets in Aswan.

Day 2- Kom Ombo & Edfu Temples

You will eat breakfast in the morning before leaving early to see the amazing [temple Kom Ombo](#). After that, you'll head back to your steamship for the Sudan Nile Cruise to unwind and enjoy lunch while taking in the stunning Aswan scenery. You will be taken on a guided tour of [Edfu Temples](#) in the afternoon. Enjoy a peaceful cruise towards Esna while dining on dinner on your steamship.

Day 3- Luxor West bank Tours

After eating breakfast in the morning, you will begin your West Bank tour of Luxor, where you will see [the Two Memnon Colossi statues](#) of King Amenhotep III and meet the deceased kings of Egypt inside their eternal palaces in [the Valley of the Kings](#). Following that, you will eat lunch outside of the country and spend the night on your Nile cruise in Luxor while enjoying dinner.

Day 4 - Luxor East Bank Tours

You will set sail for the east bank of Luxor after breakfast in order to see [the Great complex of Karnak Temple](#), which honors the Triad of Thebes—Amun, Mut, and Khonso. After lunch on board your steamship, you will return to Luxor to see the magnificent [Luxor Temple](#), which was begun by King Amenhotep III and finished by our great king Ramses II, before departing from Luxor.
