Itinerary

Day 1: Arrival Cairo \ first day of your Egypt 7-Day Itinerary

Your Cairo Top Tours tour guide will be waiting for you at <u>Cairo International Airport</u> when your flight lands, holding a sign with your name on it to start your trip to Egypt. He will go over the itinerary of your 7-day trip to Egypt with you.

The Step Pyramid of King Djoser in Saqqara, which is the oldest building in the world made entirely of stone mastabas or steps above each other, is the perfect place to begin your wonderful <u>Cairo day tours</u>. The Step Pyramid was constructed by the renowned architect and vizier of the Pharaoh named Imhotep, and Saqqara is located about 27 kilometers southwest of Cairo. It is one of the richest archeological sites in Egypt where you can see the nobles' Mastaba tombs and trace the evolution of tomb architecture throughout history.

Have your nice lunch in a beautiful restaurant, then you will transfer to the ancient capital of Egypt's old kingdom which is known as Memphis City, where you are going to see the huge statue of Ramses II and the great Alabaster Sphinx which is the second biggest sphinx after the Great Sphinx in Giza, this city was established by King Menes who united the two kingdoms of the north and the south and generated the dynastic history of the Pharaohs nearby 5100 years ago.

You will be transported to your hotel to check in after your Saqqara and Memphis day trip. Spend the night in a hotel in Cairo.

Lunch was the meal.

Day 02: Cairo Sightseeing Tour

The Hanging Church, built in the 3rd century, and the Church of St. Sergius, where the Holy Family resided, will be shown to you as you take your included breakfast in the morning and tour the ancient Roman fortress of Babylon, built by Emperor Trajan 2000 years ago. The oldest synagogue in the region, Ben Ezra, will visit

at the end of the Coptic Cairo.

Then we will visit the Egyptian Museum, which holds the largest collection of Egyptian antiquities in the world, including all the gold and silver objects of the boy-king Tutankhamun.

After lunch, we will move on to visit the <u>Saladin Citadel</u>, and we will visit the Mohammed Ali Mosque inside and enjoy a panorama of Islamic Cairo as well as modern buildings such as the Cairo Tower and the television building.

At the end of our day tours of Cairo, transfer you to <u>Islamic Cairo</u> so you can spend some time shopping in the venerable and distinctive Khan El Khalili market.

Finally, we will drive you back to your hotel for the remainder of your stay in Cairo.

Day 03: Cairo to Luxor

Your Egypt tour packages will continue after leaving your hotel in Cairo. Today you will travel to Cairo airport to take your flight to Luxor, where you will be accompanied by your personal driver and guide. After arriving in Luxor, your day tour will begin with a stop on the west bank of the city, where you can admire the colorful ancient tombs of the Valley of the Kings. Next, your guide and driver will take you to the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut, also known as the Temple of Deir El Bahari. You will visit the Colossi of Memnon as the last stop of your day tour of the west bank of Luxor.

Enjoy your lunch in a restaurant with a Nile view before continuing your tour to the East Bank of Luxor to see the Karnak and Luxor Temple.

Stay the night in Luxor.

Day 04: Edfu and Kom Ombo Tour

You will enjoy the tour of the Edfu Temple after enjoying a delicious breakfast in the hotel's main restaurant. which dates back to the worship of the ancient Egyptian god Horus and is regarded as one of the most secure temples in this region.

When you arrive at the historical <u>Temple of Kom Ombo</u>, which is perched high above the Nile and shared by the crocodile-headed Sobek, the god of fertility and the world's creator, and Haroeris, or the goddess of wisdom, your driver will then proceed north to another magnificent town as you take in the view of the magnificent river and its two green banks winding through the desert, and Horus, the falcon-headed god of the past, known as Haroeris.

When you arrive at your Aswan hotel, our representative will be there to meet you.

Day 05: Aswan Tours

After your delicious breakfast, your certified Cairo Top Tours guide will take you to begin your sightseeing in Aswan. First, you will see the incredible structure known as the High Dam, which was built to regulate the flow of the river. The dam also serves as a source of electricity. It holds back water during floods for the maximum benefit of irrigated land. as well as the Temple of Philae, which houses the Temple of Isis, which is one of the largest temples in Egypt and occupies about a quarter of the island.

After the trip, you will be transported back to the hotel. Overnight stay in Aswan.

Meals: Breakfast and lunch.

Day 06: Back to Cairo

Once you've finished your hotel breakfast, Meet your personal tour guide at the <u>Cairo International Airport</u> to begin your Cairo Day Trips. As the ancient Egyptians believed that there was life after death, they built <u>the Giza pyramids</u> of Cheops (the Greatest Pyramid, built 4,500 years ago), Chephren (the Second Pyramid, built 20 years later), and Mycerinus (the Third Pyramid), as well as the Sphinx to guard the dead kings. In order to visit the magnificent Sphinx and <u>the Valley Temple</u>, which was constructed from a combination of limestone, granite, and alabaster, we will take you there toward the end of your tour of the Giza pyramids.

You will be transferred to your hotel in Cairo afterwards the tour, where we will assist you with check-in. Meals: Breakfast

Day 07: Final Departure
