Day 2: Giza Pyramids - Saqqara Necropolis - Memphis City

Then proceed to visit the Great Sphinx, the head of the Pharaoh, the body of a lion, and the Valley Temple of King "Chephren".

It's time for lunch! you will stop to take your lunch which will be served in a good quality restaurant then you will be transferred to visit the Step Pyramid of King" Zoser in Saqqara" which is considered to be the oldest man-made building entirely made out of stone all over the world (Djoser Pyramid).

The tour includes visiting the pyramid of Teti and the tombs of nobles at Saqqara, where daily life scenes in ancient Egypt are depicted. The tour then takes you to <u>Memphis</u>, an open-air museum featuring statues and artifacts from the ancient capital, and returns to your hotel for an overnight stay.

Day 3: Tour to The Egyptian Museum - Coptic and Islamic Cairo

The Alabaster Mosque of Mohamed Ali inside the <u>Citadel of Salah El Din</u>, which represents a unique example of Ottoman architecture in Cairo because the design is modeled after the renowned Blue Mosque of Istanbul, is where your tour guide will take you to see the area known as Old Cairo. The Citadel is thought of as the center of the Egyptian government because it was built by Salah El Din during the reign of King Farouk during the first half of the previous century.

Lunch at a high-quality restaurant before visiting Coptic Cairo's ancient Roman fortress of Babylon, the Hanging Church, St. Sergius' <u>Cavern Church</u>, and <u>Ben Ezra Synagogue</u>. Visit the Hanging Church, Cavern Church, and Ben Ezra Synagogue, where legend suggests Moses picked up a basket from the Nile River.

Day 4: Cairo to Luxor - East Bank of Luxor Tour
