Day 1- Tour Of Giza Pyramids and the Egyptian Museum

When you land in Cairo, the air is thick with anticipation for the adventure that awaits you. Once you're settled in, get ready for a day of amazing exploration. we will Check in your accommodation and take a moment to absorb the atmosphere of Cairo.

Embark on a journey back in time to the [Pyramids of Giza](#), an iconic testament to the ingenuity of the ancient Egyptians. Gaze in wonder at the colossal structures of Khufu, Khafre, and Menkaure. Then, Dive into the rich tapestry of Egypt's history at [the Egyptian Museum](#). Home to a treasure trove of artifacts, mummies, and relics.

As the day winds down, indulge in the flavors of Cairo with a delectable Egyptian meal.

Day2- Bahariya Oasis Day Trip

After being picked up at your Cairo lodging around six in the morning, the trip departs the city through the nearby desert landscapes. The beautiful [Bahariya Oasis](#), which was formerly the primary agricultural hub of the Pharaonic Empire, is the day's first visit.

It is well known for having a lot of dates and olives. With the help of your guide, explore the oasis and take in the expansive setting of shaded palm trees and natural springs.

Visit the [Black Desert](#) after lunch for a breathtaking view of the region's craggy, mountain-like domes that stand out against the surrounding sand. Visit the [Agabat valley](#), which has spectacular white cliff walls and yellow limestone rocks, after that.

Continue to [Crystal Mountain](#), an incredibly rare structure that glistens and glows in the Egyptian sun and is composed completely of calcite crystal.

The White Desert, which received its name from the huge expanse of white sand it contains, is the next stop. It is possible to climb a few sand dunes for breathtaking views that never seem to end.

Finally, unwind while you travel back to Cairo; you'll get to your hotel around 11 p.m.

Day 3- Cairo to Alexandria

As the sun rises over Cairo, it's time to bid farewell to the bustling streets and venture toward the tranquil shores of Alexandria. Your first stop in Alexandria is the [Catacombs of Kom El Shoqafa](#). Descend into the fascinating underground maze, where the fusion of Egyptian, Greek, and Roman influences creates a

captivating tapestry of history. Let the echoes of the past guide you through this unique burial site.

After that, we will move to [Pompey's Pillar](#) once you are above ground. Built as an homage to Emperor Diocletian, who delivered the city from a siege and fed the starving citizens, this granite monument is 25 meters tall (82 feet). Your tour guide will also take you to the [citadel of Qaitbay](#), which was constructed in 1477 to protect the city's eastern side, continuing the Roman motif. The substantial lighthouse at Alexandria stood close to the fort.

Continue your Alexandria exploration with a visit to the modern marvel, the [Alexandria Library](#). Immerse yourself in knowledge and architectural beauty. As the day draws to a close, find a serene spot to witness the sunset over the Mediterranean. Whether it's from the Corniche or a waterfront cafe.
