#### **Itinerary**

## Day 1: Arrive Cairo, Optional Sound and Light Show in Giza Pyramids

Upon your arrival, our representative will receive you at <u>Cairo International Airport</u>, and a private airconditioned car will take you to your hotel. Upon your arrival, your low cost Cairo and Ain Sokhna tour will be updated in consultation with you to ensure all Egypt day trips are planned according to schedule and to discuss any additional Cairo sightseeing tours you wish to take. Include it in your travel packages to Egypt.

If you have enough time, you can attend the optional sound and light show at the Giza Pyramids to learn more about Egypt's history and prepare for your Giza Pyramids tour the next day.

## Day 2: Giza Pyramids, Saqqara, Memphis

Your tour guide will meet you today after you finish your open-buffet breakfast at the hotel and accompany you on your day trip from Cairo to the Giza Pyramids, Dahshur, and Memphis.

You will start your tour of the <u>Giza Pyramids</u> by visiting the famous site of the 3 great gigantic Pyramids of 3 rulers of the old kingdom (<u>Cheops</u>, <u>Chephren</u>, and <u>Menkaure</u>), descendants of King <u>Snefru</u> who was the founder of the ruling family and owner of 3 incredible pyramids in which 2 of them are sited in a necropolis in Dahshur, and the Great Sphinx which dates back to the time of King Chephren (2620 B.C).

Next, let's visit the Saqqara Necropolis, which is 200 years older than the Giza Necropolis and home to the Step Pyramid complex of King Djoser from the third dynasty and the Pyramid of King Teti from the sixth dynasty, which ruled the country until the start of the first intermediate period. Explore the tombs of the nobles, the son-in-law of King Teti, and Kagemni, the vizier of Justice, to see the exquisite examples of ancient Egyptian art.

Continue your sightseeing in Cairo by traveling to <u>Memphis</u>, an ancient city that is now known as Mit Rahina. Here, you can visit the open-air museum that features the second-largest sphinx made of alabaster and the enormous statue of King Ramses II, who was the most powerful ruler during the new kingdom.

## Day 3: Islamic Cairo, Coptic Cairo, Egyptian Museum

Following breakfast, our tour guide will come to your hotel to take you to the most popular locations in ancient Cairo. The <u>Alabaster Mosque of Mohamed Ali</u>, which gets its name from the alabaster used for both its exterior and interior walls, and Saladin Citadel will be the first stops on your amazing tour. After that, you'll stroll through Old Cairo to see the <u>Hanging Church</u>, one of the oldest churches in Egyptian Christian history. From there, you'll go to Abu Serga Church, where the holy family sought safety for nearly three months, and, to cap off your tour of Coptic Cairo, <u>Ben Ezra Synagogue</u>, which was once a Christian church before being purchased by a wealthy Jewish man.

Enjoy lunch at a neighborhood eatery. If time and energy permit, you will have the chance to visit the <u>Khan El Khalili</u> Bazaar, which is one of Cairo's best walking tours, where locals and tourists alike can enjoy themselves equally. At the conclusion of your Cairo excursions, you will be transferred back to your hotel in Cairo.

### Day 4: Red Sea El Ain Sokhna Overnight from Cairo

After checking out of the hotel, we will drive the hour and a half to the Red Sea Ain Sokhna resort. There, we will enjoy a relaxing day at the beach or in the pool, as well as a buffet lunch starting at 3:00 PM and dinner before the night show.

## Day 5: Porto Sokhna Cabla Car, Back to Cairo and End of Service

After breakfast, check out of your hotel and get started on your adventure right away! We'll drive for nearly 30 minutes to the well-known resort of Porto Sokhna, where you can ride the Cable Car (Teleferik) up the Galala Mountain and have lunch with fresh seafood at a classy restaurant with views of the mountains and the Red Sea. When your cheap tour of Cairo and El Ain Sokhna is over, tell the driver where you want to be dropped off in Cairo. After exploring the resort's mall and taking stunning pictures by the water, head back to Cairo.
