After lunch, it's time to explore Luxor's West Bank. The most well-known kings, queens, and nobles of ancient Egypt are buried in the <u>Valley of the Kings</u>, which is located there. If that's not enough, there's also the Colossi of Memnon, which consists of two enormous the Temple of Hatshepsut, and <u>Deir el-Bahri</u>, which is the Mortuary Temple of Mentuhotep II.
