Itinerary

Day 1: Arrival to Cairo airport

An experienced representative will be waiting for you at <u>Cairo International Airport</u>. After a fast check-in at your hotel, our representative will meet you to analyze your schedule and give you with all pick-up times for your tour during your stay in Egypt.

Day 2: Giza Pyramids, Dahshour tour

Our tour guide will pick you up after breakfast and transport you to the majestic <u>Giza pyramids</u>. While visiting the Great Pyramid of King Cheops, one of the Seven Wonders of the World, you may go on an adventure and explore the pyramid's interior. Then the enormous <u>Sphinx</u> that watches over the Pyramids will appear.

We next change busses to travel to the Dahshour pyramids. Visit the Red and Bent Pyramids in <u>Dahshour</u>, which were built by King Cheops' father, King Sinfru. Learn about the mistakes that the ancient Egyptians made when building the pyramids.

After that, grab lunch at a local restaurant before returning to your accommodation.

Day 3: (NMEC) & Sultan Hassan mosque

Your next trip will be the National Museum of Egyptian Civilization (NEMC). It is widely recognized as the first museum in the world to give a comprehensive overview of Egyptian civilization from prehistory to current times.

NMEC has several items on exhibit to provide visitors a taste of Egyptian civilization over the centuries, beginning with predynastic and ancient Egypt.

Then we'll go to Citadel Square. We'll visit the <u>Sultan Hassan Mosque</u>, a magnificent Mamluke edifice constructed in 1359. <u>El-Rifai mosque</u> (1912), with its distinctive style and spectacular prayer hall decorations, and Sultan Hassan mosque are emblems of old Islamic Egypt, as are the Giza pyramids of ancient pharaonic Egypt.

At the end of the day, a driver will return you to your hotel!

Day 4: Embarkation in Luxor

After breakfast, meet our tour guide at the Luxor train station or airport. He'll be holding a sign with your name and the Cairo Top Tours logo on it.

After landing in Luxor, you will be taken for roughly 30 minutes in a private, non-smoking air-conditioned car to your cruise, where you will be able to experience the fascination of the limitless river while learning about Egyptian history.

You may have your lunch on the Nile cruise after checking in and relaxing in your cabin for a while before we begin exploring Luxor's major attractions.

You will travel to Luxor's East Bank. The complex of <u>Karnak Temples</u>, which was built over two millennia to serve as a natural museum of ancient Egyptian art, a blueprint of the majesty and splendor of a golden period, and a storehouse of historical information, serves as the starting point for tours.

After that, go to the <u>Temple of Luxor</u> to see another example of the importance of the New Kingdom pharaohs. Day 6: Edfu Temple and Kom Ombo Sightseeing

You'll embark on a magnificent tour of the <u>Kom Ombo temples</u>, which were created to honor two gods because the inhabitants didn't want a deity who symbolized evil and the crocodile <u>god Sobek</u>. As soon as your tea is finished, board your Nile River Cruise, which will depart for Aswan. You can enjoy the evening meal and entertainment before retiring for another peaceful night by the Nile.

Day 7: Aswan Sightseeing tour

Day 9: Transfer to Fayoum

The 48-meter-long pyramid is located in the <u>Fayoum Governorate</u>. The pyramid's center core is situated on a high hill and is totally made of granite stones. Tunnels beneath the pyramid led to the chamber where <u>King Senusret II</u> was interred.

Visitors may take a guided tour of the museum, observe the artifacts on display, and read the identifying panels for each piece. Among the most notable archaeological relics, sculptures, and artifacts on display in Kom Oshim Museum are mummy portraits from the Ptolemaic village of Karanis discovered in Fayoum.

Following that, you'll have a fantastic supper in an Asian restaurant.

Then, enjoy a felucca excursion along the massive Nile River.

We shall subsequently conclude our service and transport you to the drop-off site.

Day 10: Transfer to Bahariya Oasis / White Desert

The White Desert Safari is a one-of-a-kind adventure that brings you to the <u>Valley of El Haize</u>, a green village before entering the black desert, and Crystal Mountain, an old quartz crystal formation. You'll pass through the <u>Valley of Agabat</u>, where you may sandboard down massive sand dunes and marvel at the amazing landforms. Camping in the White Desert allows you to see a gorgeous sunset before waking up to a lovely dawn and admiring the stars the next morning.

Day 11: Back to Bahariya\ Cairo
