Itinerary

Day 1: Arrival to Alexandria and Check-in

Our agent will be waiting for you outside your terminal when your aircraft arrives at <u>Alexandria Burg El</u> <u>Arab Airport</u>. He will be holding a sign with your name on it and will be taking you to your hotel, the Hilton Green Plaza Hotel or something similar.

When you arrive at the hotel, our representative will assist you with checking in and beginning your vacation experiences. He will ensure that you have all you need to enjoy your tour, and you may then change your itinerary as you see appropriate.

Day 2: Alexandria sightseeing

You'll meet your English-speaking Egyptologist guide after breakfast to begin your tour of Alexandria. Begin your tour with Pompey's Pillar, which was constructed in 297 BC to commemorate a Roman emperor named Diocletian's (who controlled Rome between 284 and 305 BC and subsequently gained control of Egypt) victory over a revolt in Alexandria. Then you'll be taken to the Catacombs of Kom El Shokkafa, which were found as early as the twentieth century and are regarded one of the largest Roman burial sites.

After there, you'll travel down the coast to the <u>Citadel of Qaitbay</u>, which was erected on the ruins of Alexandria's old Lighthouse Pharos. It is located at the end of a small strip of land stretching into the Eastern Port.

The <u>Bibliotheca of Alexandria</u> is history's earliest scientific research facility. It was founded in the early third century BC and is located in the city that bears its name, which faces the Mediterranean.

You can't go to <u>Alexandria</u> and not eat fish! Today, enjoy your meal created with the finest ingredients before we bring you to the hotel.

Day 3: Pyramids and Egyptian Muesum

In the morning, enjoy a great breakfast at your Alexandria hotel. Then, our authorized tour guide will meet you and take you to Cairo to view the <u>Giza Pyramids</u>. The Great Pyramid of Cheops is a massive pyramid in Egypt's Giza Necropolis. It is one of the world's most renowned pyramids.

During the Old Kingdom, the Great Pyramid was erected 4500 years ago. You may explore it or snap photographs as your tour guide informs you about the pyramid's history.

Finally head to the Egyptian Museum, Egypt's most famous museum, holds a significant collection of ancient Egyptian antiquities.
