There are various dining options near the Giza Plateau, ranging from local Egyptian cuisine to international restaurants. Enjoy a leisurely lunch to recharge.

After lunch, drive to the <u>Saqqara Necropolis</u>, which is about 30 kilometers south of Giza. Saqqara is known for its <u>Step Pyramid</u>, which is considered the world's oldest major stone structure.

You will also visit the <u>pyramid of Teti</u>, founder of the Sixth Dynasty who ruled Egypt after Pharaoh Unas, and <u>Tombs of the nobles</u> at Saqqara to gain a glimpse of daily life in ancient Egypt with all its activities engraved and painted on the walls and corridors of those 4000 years old tombs.

Head back to Cairo in the late afternoon, where you can relax at your hotel, freshen up, or do some shopping for souvenirs and local crafts.

Day 3: Cairo Tours

Today, you'll delve into the rich history of Cairo by exploring its historic and Coptic Christian sites. This itinerary will take you through some of the city's most significant landmarks, providing a deep understanding of its cultural and religious heritage.

Start your day with a delicious Egyptian breakfast at your hotel or a local cafe. Fuel up for a day of exploration. Begin your historic journey at the <u>Egyptian Museum</u>, where the largest collection of Egyptian antiquities is located all over the world.
