Day1- Tour To Pyramids Of Giza ,the Egyptian museum and old cairo.

On your first day in Cairo, we have an exciting private excursion planned for you. At 8 a.m., our friendly tour guide will pick you up from your hotel. Our first stop will be the Great Pyramid of Giza, which is the largest and oldest pyramid in the [Giza pyramid](#) complex. Next, we'll visit the Pyramid of Chephren, the second-tallest and largest pyramid in Giza. We'll also take you to the King Chephren Valley Temple, where you'll get a closer look at the magnificent [Great Sphinx](#). The Sphinx is a legendary creature with the body of a lion and the head of King Chephren. You'll have the chance to go on a camel ride near the pyramids, which is a fun and unique experience. Our next stop is the [Egyptian Museum](#). You'll have the opportunity to see the famous display dedicated to King Tutankhamun, showcasing his treasures and gold unearthed from his tomb. We'll then drive to the [Saladin Citadel](#). For lunch, we'll take you to an Egyptian restaurant where you can savor delicious local cuisine. In the afternoon, we'll explore Old Cairo and visit its iconic landmarks, such as the Hanging Church, Ben Ezra Synagogue, Church of St. Barbara, and the ancient Church of Abu Serga. These sites hold great historical and religious importance. If time permits, we'll also take you to [Khan el-Khalili](#), a vibrant and bustling market that has been a center of commerce in Cairo for centuries. It's a fascinating place to wander through the maze-like streets and indulge in some shopping. After an eventful day, we'll return you to your hotel in Cairo for a restful overnight stay.

Day2- Cairo to the Bahariya oasis and white desert

A representative will meet you at your hotel in Giza or Cairo to start your journey to the [Bahariya Oasis](#). The drive to the White Desert and Bahariya Oasis takes around four hours. Once you arrive, your safari guide will greet you and take you on a thrilling adventure in a 4x4 Jeep. You'll embark on a car ride through the dark desert, named for the thin layer of black powder that covers the mountains, hills, and dunes. At [El Haize Oasis](#), you'll enjoy a delicious lunch surrounded by the picturesque landscape. Before lunch, you can relax and unwind in a natural hot spring. The soothing heat of the spring promotes a sense of calmness and tranquility. During your journey, you'll make a stop at Gebel al-Izzaz, also known as [Crystal Mountain](#). For a unique and breathtaking experience, make sure to visit the [Valley of Agabat](#) in the heart of the white desert. This surreal landscape has been sculpted by millions of years of water erosion. After exploring the valley, you can have an exhilarating sandboarding adventure down Wadi el Agabat with the help of a Jeep 4x4. After the tour, you will be transferred back to Cairo, where you can reflect on the unforgettable experiences and mesmerizing landscapes you encountered during your time in the White Desert and Bahariya Oasis.

Day3- Cairo to Alexandria

We will start our day by meeting the Egyptologists at 7:00 am in your Cairo accommodation. From there, we will embark on a private tour of Alexandria, located about 220 kilometers northwest of Cairo. Alexandria is a fascinating city with a rich history. Our first stop will be the [Kom el Shoqafa catacombs](#), believed to have been built around the second century A.D. Next, we will visit [Pompey's Pillar](#). It was likely built as a memorial to the Roman emperor Diocletian. Our journey will then take us to the [Qaitbay Citadel](#), constructed by Sultan Qaitbay in the 15th century as a defense against the Crusaders. Afterward, we will enjoy a delicious lunch at an Egyptian restaurant to refuel and savor local cuisine. Our next stop is the [Library of Alexandria](#), a significant cultural and educational complex. The library was reopened in October 2002,

aiming to revive its glorious past. Finally, we will return to your Cairo hotel, where you can rest and reflect on the captivating sights and knowledge you gained during our tour of Alexandria.

Day4- Final Departure

On the last day of your tour, you will have breakfast at the hotel before checking out. Please make sure to leave the hotel by 12:00 PM to allow time for any optional day trips you may have planned in Cairo. After experiencing the wonders of Cairo over the past four days, your private Egyptologist guide will accompany you to the Cairo airport for your departure. They will assist you with any necessary arrangements and bid you a fond farewell.
