Day 1 : Arrival Cairo

The tour guide from Cairo Top Tours will meet you at [Cairo International Airport](#) when you arrive in Egypt. He will be holding a sign with your name on it. You will then be driven in a contemporary, nice vehicle with air conditioning to your hotel. You will be given a welcome drink at the hotel as our representative helps you check in without incident and goes over your Egypt Easter Tours with you to arrange and confirm pick-up times for each day tour.

Day 2 : Pyramids Tour

Once you've enjoyed a delightful breakfast at your Cairo hotel, you'll meet with your tour guide to kick-start your day's activities.

First, you will visit [Giza Pyramids](#), are a must-visit attraction. These ancient wonders, including the Great Pyramid of Khufu, the Pyramid of Khafre, and the Pyramid of Menkaure, stand as a testament to the ingenuity and architectural prowess of the ancient Egyptians.

Having eaten lunch at a local eatery, we went on to [Saqqara](#) an archaeological complex that holds great historical importance. One of its most notable features is the Step Pyramid of Djoser, which is considered one of the earliest colossal stone buildings in Egypt. Explore the vast necropolis in Saqqara.

After that, you'll be traveling to [Memphis](#) King Narmer, who lived about 3,200 years ago, founded Memphis. It is still a significant city today despite once serving as Egypt's capital. You will go to an outdoor museum to see a lot of well-known monuments, like two statues of King Ramses II and the Sphinx of Memphis made of alabaster.

Our representative will take stunning pictures to capture this moment for you and will assist you in fully comprehending this historical location.

Return to your hotel to spend the night in Cairo.

Day 3: Cairo Tour

Your knowledgeable tour guide will accompany you as you leave the hotel in Cairo after finishing your delectable breakfast to visit The [Egyptian Museum](#) is a treasure trove of ancient Egyptian artifacts and antiquities.

Then proceed to the [Citadel of Saladin](#), a former fortress with important cultural and architectural significance. It was constructed in the 12th century by the renowned Muslim general Saladin to serve as a medieval fortress to keep the city safe from potential invasions.

Continue to Coptic Cairo tours to see the [Hanging Church](#), which is suspended above the ancient bastions of Babylon's Roman fortress, the Church of St. Sergius, which contains the holy family's crypt and the spring where they drank water, and Ben Ezra Synagogue, which is rumored to be the location of the pharaoh's palace where Moses' basket was retrieved from the Nile.

Our tours of Islamic Cairo will continue as we explore the walls, gates, and historic streets of this medieval city, some of which date back to the 10th century. The walk will end with tea at Fishawy's oldest cafe in [Khan El Khalili](#), Cairo's historic bazaar.

Back to the hotel and overnight in Cairo.
