Once located on Philae Island, the temple was relocated to Agilika Island following the construction of the high dam, which resulted in Philae Island being submerged.

Your journey continues to the Unfinished Obelisk, a colossal marvel left unfinished by the ancient Egyptians during the reign of Queen Hatshepsut. The obelisk remains in its original location, still partially carved from

solid rock in the granite quarries near Aswan.
