# Day 02: The Great Pyramid, Egyptian Museum, Coptic Cairo

After you finish eating breakfast, you will go on an interesting tour in Cairo to see the big pyramids in Giza. they were built a long time ago by ancient Egyptians. They were very important because they were made for religious reasons and to bury important leaders, like kings. The pyramids in Giza were built to show respect to the pharaoh and to be his resting place when he died. They also show how smart and skilled the ancient Egyptians were.

There are three main pyramids there: <u>King Cheops | King Khufu | Owner Of The Great Pyramid</u>, Khafre, and Menkaure. They are different sizes, with Khufu being the tallest, Khafre, and Menkaure being the smallest.

Your guide and driver will show you around <u>the Egyptian Museum</u>. You will see amazing things from a famous king named Tutankhamun, and it will make you very happy and excited.

After we eat at a nearby restaurant, we'll keep exploring a special part of Cairo Coptic Cairo. We'll see old churches and synagogues. First, we'll go to <u>the Hanging Church</u>, which was built on top of some old ruins from a long time ago.
