Itinerary

Day 1: Arrive Cairo, Check-In

When you arrive at the <u>Cairo International Airport</u>, there will be your tour guide waiting for you. They will take you to your hotel in a special car. At the hotel, they will help you with the check-in process and make sure your plans for <u>Egypt Easter Tours</u> are just right. And when you get to the hotel, they will give you a special drink to welcome you. You have two choices for the rest of the day. You can either have fun and do whatever you want, or you can choose one of our special trips in Cairo to start your vacation in Egypt.

Day 2: Giza Pyramids, Egyptian Museum

In the morning, after your breakfast with a buffet at the hotel. Then, we will take you to see the <u>Giza</u> <u>Pyramids | Necropolis Of Giza</u>. When we get there, you will see a really amazing and beautiful building right in front of you.

Your tour guide will teach you all about how the big pyramids were built. Then you can see all three of them together - Cheops, Chephren, and Mycerinus. They were all part of the same family who ruled a long time ago. You can also ride a camel and see the pretty desert around the Giza Plateau if you want (optional).

We will continue our visit to the Giza Pyramids to see how the buildings were made in the Valley Temple of King Chephren. We will also see the Great Sphinx, which is a huge statue of a lion with a man's head. It was made by carving it out of a big rock. The statue is 73 meters long.

First, we will have lunch at a restaurant in Egypt. After that, we will go to a museum in a special place called Tahrir Square. We will spend about 2 hours there looking at really important things from a long time ago in Egypt. The Egyptian Museum In Cairo has lots of different things from different times in history, but the most popular is the stuff that belonged to a king named Tutankhamun. Lots of people like to see that the most.

After the tour is finished, you will be taken back to the hotel to spend the night.

Day 3: Fly to Aswan, Aswan Excursions

After you finish eating your breakfast, someone from our team will take you to the airport in Cairo. From there, you will get on a plane to go to Aswan.

When you arrive in Aswan, a special Egyptologist will meet you and take you on some fun adventures. First, you will go to see a big dam called the Aswan The High Dam. This dam helps keep the Nile River from flooding Egypt every year. Next, you will visit some big rocks where a giant stone obelisk was supposed to have been made a long time ago. But for some reason, it was never finished or used. After that, you will go to a really pretty temple called the Philae Temple | Temple Of Isis. It was made a long time ago for the goddess Isis, and it is very beautiful to look at.

After you arrive, you will go to your hotel in Aswan to check in and stay the night. Before that, you will have a yummy lunch at one of the really good restaurants in Aswan.

Day 4: Luxor Tours

After having breakfast at the hotel, you will go to Luxor in a special car with a guide. You will get to see lots of cool things in Luxor, starting with the **Karnak Temple** | **The Largest Egyptian Temple**. This temple was built by many kings a long time ago and was a very important place for worship in ancient Egypt. It was really big and people thought it was the most special place in Egypt.

In Luxor, there is a special place called the <u>Valley Of The Kings</u> where the kings of Egypt were buried a long time ago. You can go on a tour to see the tombs of three kings. One of the tombs, called King Tutankhamun's tomb, became very famous when it was found with lots of golden treasures inside in 1902.

You can also go to a special temple that was made for Queen Hatshepsut during her time as ruler. It was built by her trusted architect Senmout and is dedicated to Queen Hatshepsut and the god Amun. Inside the temple, you can see pictures that tell the story of how Queen Hatshepsut became a queen. After that, you can continue your tour in Luxor and see the big statues of King Amenhotep III, who started building the Luxor Temple.

After you finish eating your lunch, you will go to your hotel in Luxor to check in and stay for the night.

Day 5: Fly to Cairo, Islamic and Coptic Cairo Tours

In the morning, after you have your breakfast in Luxor, a pretty city in Egypt, the tour leader will be there to go with you to the airport. You'll take a flight back to Cairo.

We will start our tour in a special area called **Coptic Cairo | Old Cairo**. Our first stop will be at a very old fortress called Babylon. It was built a long time ago, during the time of the Romans. On top of this fortress, there is a special church called the Hanging Church. After that, we will visit another church called the Church of St. Sergius and Bachus. This church is very old too, it was built a long time ago, during the time of the fifth century. Inside this church, there is a special place called a crypt. This is where the holy family stayed for three months a very long time ago. Finally, we will see the oldest synagogue in the area, called Ben Ezra. This synagogue used to belong to the Christians, but they sold it to a rich Jewish man because they had to pay a lot of taxes. It is a very important place for Jewish people.

You can have lunch at a restaurant in Egypt and then go on a special tour. We will visit a big castle called **Mosque Of Muhammad Ali | The Alabaster Mosque In Cairo**. there is a beautiful mosque called the Alabaster Mosque of Mohamed Ali. It looks a lot like the Blue Mosque in Istanbul and was built by a person named Mohamed Ali Basha. He is even buried inside the mosque!

After you finish exploring Egypt during the day, you will go back to the hotel in Cairo to check in and sleep for the night.
