Itinerary

Day 1: Arrive Cairo, Egypt

When you get to the airport in Cairo, our representative will be there to meet you at <u>Cairo International</u> Airport. They will take you to your hotel in Cairo.

When you get to the hotel, someone will give you a special drink to welcome you. They will also check your schedule for the next 5-day. We will help you easily and quickly check check-in.

Day 2: Giza Pyramids, Saqqara Necropolis, Memphis City

Have a Delicious breakfast at the hotel and then meet your tour guide who will show you around Cairo. First, you will get to visit the incredible Pyramids called Cheops, Chephren, and Mycerinus. These pyramids were made a long time ago and were built to be the final resting places for special kings who were like half-gods. The biggest pyramid belonged to King Cheops, and your guide will explain more about why and how these amazing pyramids were made.

You'll get to see <u>The Great Sphinx Of Giza Facts</u>. It looks like a lion with a man's head and it's as tall as a 73-story building! You'll also visit another building called the Valley Temple, which is part of the place where King Chephren was buried.

Your driver will take you to Saqqara Necropolis. It's about 45 minutes away from Cairo. In Saqqara Necropolis, there is a very old pyramid made of stone the Step Pyramid. It was built a long time ago by a famous architect named Imhotep for his king Djoser. This pyramid is special because it shows how the tombs of kings changed over time. It's an amazing place to go and explore!

We have a chance to go see the **Pyramid Of Teti At Saqqara** and the tomb of his son-in-law, Kagemni. Teti was a king a long time ago, and his tomb is special.

Enjoy your delicious lunch in an Egyptian restaurant.

Next, you will go to Memphis, which is now called Mit Rahina. There, you will visit an outdoor museum that has cool old things, like a statue of a lion made of a special white stone called alabaster. You will also see a giant statue of a king named Ramses II, who was a very important ruler a long time ago. He even has a really big temple named Abu Simbel in another city called Aswan.

Once your day trip is finished, you will go back to your hotel and stay there for the night.

Day 3: Fly to Luxor, East Bank Tours

Our representative will take you to the airport to take your flight. a special tour guide will be there to greet you. Let's begin our Luxor Day adventure with a fun tour of the <u>Luxor Temple</u> on the east side of the city. This temple is really special because it was built a long time ago by a king named Amenhotep III, and then finished by other kings and rulers of ancient Egypt. religion was to the ancient Egyptians and how amazing their civilization was.

You will go through a special path with cool statues called sphinx to get to the TKarnak Temple | The Largest Egyptian Temple. This temple was really important to the people because it was where they practiced their religion and made important decisions. Lots of different pharaohs worked on building this temple over a long time, which is why it became the biggest temple in the whole world.

We will go to a restaurant in Luxor to have lunch before going to the hotel to check in and stay overnight.

Day 4: Luxor West Bank Tours, Fly Back to Cairo

After eating breakfast at the hotel, you will meet a special guide who knows a lot about Egypt. You will go on a tour of Luxor and see some cool things. We are going to visit a special place called <u>The Mortuary Temple Of Hatshepsut At Deir El-Bahri</u>. Her temple is amazing and one of the best in Egypt. Hatshepsut made lots of important changes in Egypt, especially in trading.

You will be driven in a special car to the Luxor airport. From there, you will fly to Cairo. When you arrive in Cairo, your tour leader will be there to meet you and take you to your hotel. You will stay there for the night.

Inside, there is a main part and two smaller parts on the sides. We can see old pictures and special things that are important to the church. Then, we will go to another church called St. Sergius, where Mary and baby Jesus stayed for three months a long time ago. After that, we will visit a place called the Synagogue of Ben Ezra. This happened a long time ago when Islamic Cairo was around.

Have a delicious lunch at a nice restaurant that makes food from Egypt. Then, go to an old market called **Khan El Khalili**. You'll have so much fun exploring the area of Islamic Cairo and buying things to remember your amazing time in Cairo.

After that, you will go to Cairo International Airport to catch your plane home.
