Day 1 Thursday: Arrive Luxor - Luxor East Bank Tours

Day 2 Friday: Luxor West Bank Tours - Sail to Edfu

After eating breakfast on a cruise in Egypt, you will go on a tour of Luxor. One of the places you can visit is the <u>Valley Of The Kings In Luxor</u>, where the pharaohs from a long time ago were buried. like one that shows a big trial with lots of gods. Some of the gods you might see are Osiris, Maat, and Anubis.

Visit <u>The Mortuary Temple Of Hatshepsut At Deir El-Bahri</u>, which was built for a queen who ruled a long time ago. It is located on the Nile River in the city of Luxor. The temple was made for the queen to do special ceremonies for the afterlife. After visiting the temple, you will visit two big statues called the <u>Colossi Of Memnon</u>, which represent another pharaoh.

Have a delicious lunch and dinner with lots of food options on the cruise as you sail to **Edfu | The Temple Of Horus** on the Nile River.

Day 3 Saturday: Edfu and Kom Ombo Temples

After we eat breakfast on the boat, we will go on a tour to see two ancient temples. The first one is called the **Edfu | The Temple Of Horus**, and it was dedicated to the Egyptian god Horus, who had the body of a man and the head of a hawk. Then we will go to the **Kom Ombo Temple | Temple Of Sobek And Horus**, this temple is famous and not far from where your cruise stops if you're on a cruise. It's special because it has two entrances for two gods. They also have a museum with mummified crocodiles. The temple was built a long time ago when the Ptolemaic dynasty ruled. Finally, we will sail to Aswan and see the pretty sights along the Nile River.

Day 4 Sunday: Aswan Sightseeing Tours

After eating a fancy breakfast, we will go on a trip to Aswan to see two places. The Aswan The High Dam was built in the 1960s by President Nasser to stop floods in Egypt every year. It is a popular place to visit in Aswan.

The Aswan High Dam is a big wall that holds back a river in Egypt to control the flow of water and create electricity. Next, we will go on a tour to see the **Philae Temple | Temple Of Isis** in Aswan, which is a very old and special temple in Egypt. The temple has beautiful stones and carvings that have been preserved for a long time, and they show us how great our ancestors were. After that, we will take you back to the cruise ship, where you will have lunch and dinner.
