Itinerary

Day1- arrive cairo, pyramids, old cairo and papyrus institute

Welcome to Cairo, Egypt.

Upon your arrival at <u>Cairo Airport</u>, your Cairo Top Tours tour leader will be waiting to meet you and pick you up from Cairo Airport, where our tour guide will be waiting for you in an air-conditioned car. Let's take you immediately to the <u>Giza Pyramids</u> Necropolis, where you can visit the great pyramids of <u>Khufu</u>, <u>Khafre</u>, and <u>Menkaure</u> and ride a camel to explore the region's magnificent Giza Plateau.

Our next stop will be The Papyrus Institute, where we can learn more about the ancient Egyptian craft of making papyrus. and we'll have the chance to make our own papyrus scrolls after learning about papyrus production.

After that, it will be time for lunch at a nearby neighborhood restaurant in the heart of Cairo. After a brief break, we'll visit the historic district of Cairo to admire its stunning buildings, including those of Coptic Cairo, Islamic Cairo, Al-Azhar, and Khan Al-Khalili, where our day tour ends.

After that, we will return you to your hotel in Cairo so you can check in, stay overnight, and rest up.

Day 2 - Fly to Luxor-Luxor Museum & Mummification Museum Tour

Have breakfast at the hotel. After that, our tour guide will pick you up from your hotel and take you to Cairo Airport to catch your flight to Luxor. Once we arrive here, your tour guide will take you to your hotel in Luxor, where you can relax before we start our journey to the first stop.

You will start your trip by visiting the <u>Luxor Museum</u>. The Luxor Museum is considered one of the most important and vital places because it contains the most famous selections of ancient antiquities. It is also considered one of the best museums in the world. It is located on the edge overlooking the Nile River and contains many treasures from different eras in Egyptian history, in addition to many rare objects found in Luxor, including statues of kings and gods. The museum also displays some pieces of <u>King Tutankhamun</u> that were found in the Valley of the Kings in Luxor.

Next, you will visit the <u>Mummification Museum</u>, which is the best place to learn the secrets of the Pharaohs. An impressive collection of stuffed animals can be discovered. The museum contains many human and animal mummies.

The Mummification Museum is a unique institution located in the heart of Luxor, Egypt. This museum is dedicated to showcasing the ancient Egyptians' practice of mummification, which played a crucial role in their beliefs about the afterlife. The museum's stunning architecture, reminiscent of ancient Egyptian temples, invites visitors to explore the secrets of this timeless tradition.

Following that, we'll make a lunch stop at a nearby eatery before returning you to your hotel in Luxor for the evening.

Day 3- Day Tour to the East Bank of Luxor

After breakfast, our tour guide will pick you up from your hotel to visit the architectural marvel known as the Valley of the Kings, which serves as a place of burial and is home to numerous kings' graves. The tombs of King Tutmosis I, King Tutmosis III, Tut-Ankh-Amon, King Ramses VI, King Mrenptah, and Amenhotep II are the most well-known.

Then go to see the Temple of <u>Queen Hatshepsut</u>, also known as <u>Deir el-Bahari</u>. The daughter of Pharaoh Thutmose I and the only female to rule ancient Egypt, Queen Hatshepsut, built this temple. She ruled Egypt for nearly 20 years and supervised the construction of the temple during the Eighteenth Dynasty (ca. 1490–1469 BC). will then be our next stop is <u>The Colossi of Memnon</u>, which are the remnants of Amenhotep III's funerary temple

We'll have lunch at a nearby restaurant after that, and then we'll drop you off at your hotel for the evening.

Day4- Day Trip to Edfu and Kom Ombo from Luxor

After breakfast, check out of the hotel, and our tour guide will take you to see the Temple of Horus, the most important structure in Edfu and one of the most amazing and well-preserved Egyptian temples.

Then, you will visit the Kom Ombo Temple. Kom Ombo Temple is one of the must-see stops on all Nile cruises in Egypt. It was built during the Ptolemaic Dynasty, but some expansions were added to it later during the Roman era in Egypt.

After that, we'll have lunch at a nearby restaurant before transporting you to your Aswan lodging for the evening.

Day5- Aswan High Dam and the Abu Simbel Temple

Have breakfast at the hotel, after which you will be picked up from the hotel by our tour guide. Then start your tour by visiting the <u>High Dam</u>. It is an engineering marvel from the 1960s. From the top of the High Dam, you can see Lake Nasser, <u>the Kalabsha Temple</u> to the south, the huge power station to the north, and everything in between.

Then take an air-conditioned car for a 3-hour trip south from Aswan to experience a day tour of <u>Abu Simbel</u>. This large temple was dedicated to the protector gods of ancient Egypt. Amun of Thebes (currently Luxor), Ptah of Memphis (the capital of Egypt in the Old Kingdom era), and Ra

Ramesses II erected the smallest temple at Abu Simbel in memory of his dear wife Nefertari, and it is dedicated to the goddess of love, Hathor.

Ramesses II, Hathor, and the Sun God are symbolically united in the Temple of Queen Nefertari, also referred to as the Temple of Hathor because she was the Sun God's wife.

take you back to your hotel, where you will eat lunch and stay the night.

Day6- Visit Philae Temple and fly to Cairo

After breakfast, check out of your lodging, and our tour guide will take you up to visit You will view the third and biggest of the famous Aswan sights.

Following the construction of the High Dam, which raised the nearby Nile levels (about 500 meters from the original site), Philae Temple was carefully moved to its current location.

Your tour guide will give you a walking tour of the temple after you arrive at the island by speedboat, then give you some free time to finish your independent research.

The Philae Temple, which honors the goddess Isis, can be found in a stunning setting on an island in the river that has been meticulously maintained to match its original site.

When your trip is over, you will be dropped off at the Aswan airport so you can catch your flight to Cairo.

Day7- White Desert and Bahariya Oasis Tour

At 6:00 in the morning, our tour guide and driver will pick you up from your hotel in Cairo and drive you 350 kilometers west of Giza to the Bahariya Oasis in a private, air-conditioned vehicle.

The trip takes roughly four hours.

Once you arrive in Baharaia, change to a 44 and travel 40 kilometers into the desert to see the Black Desert.

The well-known neighborhood restaurant will then serve lunch, where you can swim and relax before or after.

Turn left to enter the White Desert, one of the most picturesque deserts in the entire world, and continue for another 90 km to reach the Agbatat and Crystal deserts as well as a number of mountains and sand dunes. There are many different shapes of its stunning white pebbles, including mushrooms, chickens, and bunnies. Return by car to your lodging in Cairo.

Day8- arrive Alexandria

When you check out in the morning after breakfast, your tour guide will drive you in a modern, air-conditioned vehicle to Alexandria. The catacombs at Kom el Shoqafa, which are regarded as one of the wonders of the Middle Ages, will be the first stop on this day trip. With three floors of tombs that could hold as many as 300 bodies, it is the largest Roman burial site in Egypt that is currently known to exist. The area had originally been developed as a private burial ground for a single-family before becoming a public cemetery. The tombs' architecture is reminiscent of Greco-Roman designs.

You will then move on to <u>Qaitbay Citadel</u>, which is believed to be one of the most important defensive strongholds not only in Egypt but also along the Mediterranean coast. In the fifteenth century AD, the castle played an important role in Alexandria's defense system. It is located not far from the entrance to the eastern port at the easternmost point of Pharos Island. In the same place where the famous Lighthouse of Alexandria once stood, one of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World.

After that, the royal palaces and gardens of Montazah, which belonged to the Muhammad Ali family, will be visited. The modern Library of Alexandria, which replaced the ancient library and was famous for its wide

collection of books in various sciences and literary genres, is the place where our amazing journey will end. You will be picked up and returned to your accommodation in Alexandria after this wonderful city tour.

Day 9 - Alexandria tour - back Cairo

Check out of the hotel after breakfast, and then be picked up by our tour guide in an air-conditioned car to go to <u>Pompei's Pillar</u>, which is located on the site of the temple of Serapis, which was built in the first century BC and was referred to as "the supreme god of Alexandria during the Ptolemaic era."

The largest mosque in Alexandria is called <u>Abu Al-Abbas Al-Mursi</u> and has a cream-colored facade, four massive domes, arabesque carvings, and a towering minaret.

Our tour of Alexandria concludes at the Roman Amphitheatre, also known as Kom el-Dikka. Right in the center of Alexandria is a sizable Roman theater and residential complex.

Before being driven to your hotel in Cairo by one of our tour guides, take a stroll through Alexandria's historic district.

Day 10- Final Departure
