#### **Itinerary**

### Day 1: Arrive Cairo, Optional Tour

Our tour leader will meet you at Cairo International Airport and accompany you to your hotel in Cairo, assisting you with check-in procedures and revising your 6 Days Cairo and <u>Hurghada</u> Wheelchair Accessible Tour schedule.

This evening, you can take an optional Nile cruise dinner and enjoy a delicious dinner buffet while sailing the Nile River aboard a Nile cruise boat for 2 hours. A lovely oriental display (belly dancing) and Tanoura dance show will entertain you throughout your Nile cruise dinner in Cairo.

### Day 2: Pyramids, Dahshur, Memphis

After breakfast in the hotel, you will be welcomed by your tour guide, who will accompany you on your tour to the Giza Pyramids, Dahshur, and Memphis.

Begin your trips with a tour of the <u>Giza Pyramids</u>, where you will be astounded by the size of these massive structures built during the old kingdom of ancient Egypt history by the most powerful kings and rulers of ancient Egypt as proof of the success they achieved 4500 years ago thanks to the Nile River.

See the Great Pyramid of King Cheops, who was influenced by his father's attempts to construct massive burial tombs, King Cheops (that was constructed his pyramid using more than 2.3 million limestone blocks to serve as the eternal home from which he would rise to the heavens, the building stood at a height of 146 meters with 230 meters long for each side).

going by the high plateau to enjoy a picturesque perspective of the 3 pyramids of Cheops, Chephren, and Mycerinus. Chephren, Cheops' son, built his pyramid slightly smaller than his father's, with a height of 136 meters and some traces of the outer casing at the top.

See the Great Sphinx in Giza, a statue of a man-headed lion that is said to have been built by King Chephren himself because it stands within his pyramid complex, and see the Valley Temple, where the king was mummified as part of the burial ritual.

Continue your tours in Cairo by visiting the ancient city of Memphis, now known as Mit Rahina, and seeing the open-air museum with the second-largest alabaster sphinx and the colossal statue of King Ramses II, one of Egypt's most powerful kings during the new kingdom.

Transfer to the Dahshur Archaeological Site to visit the Bent Pyramid and the Red Pyramid, two of four pyramids built for King Snefru, the 4th dynasty's founder and the father of King Cheops. The Bent Pyramid maintains a large portion of its outer casing material, making it one of Egypt's most unusual pyramids. The Red Pyramid is distinguished by the reddish tint of the limestone blocks used in its construction and is regarded as Egypt's first perfect-shaped pyramid.

Before being transferred back to your hotel, you will have a gourmet lunch at a high-quality restaurant overlooking the Giza Pyramids.

# Day 3: Fly to Hurghada, Optional Hurghada Bedouin Desert Safari By Jeep

After breakfast, transfer to Cairo airport to catch your flight to <u>Hurghada</u>. When you arrive in Hurghada, you will be welcomed by our tour leader who will transfer you to the hotel and assist you with all check-in requirements. You can spend the rest of the day relaxing by the pool or watching the night show, or you can go on an optional Hurghada Bedouin Safari by Jeep at sunset, or any of our other Hurghada excursions.

Visit the Hanging Church of the Holy Virgin Mary, which was built above the ruins of the Roman fortress of Babylon, and the church of St Sergius, also known as the cavern church, which contains the well from which the holy family obtained their necessary water while taking refuge in the crypt inside, as well as the Ben Ezra Synagogue, which was once a Coptic church before it was sold and was transformed into a Jewish synagogue.

After your lunch in a restaurant, following that, we will begin our Cairo day tours with an Egyptian Museum, where we will see the most ancient objects inside the Egyptian Museum in Cairo, which opened to the public in 1902 to hold the largest collection of ancient artifacts.

Finally, you will be transferred to Cairo's oldest market, the Khan El Khalili bazaar, for an unforgettable shopping experience.

You will be transferred to your hotel in Cairo for check-in and overnight stay.
