In Alexandria, you may visit interesting Greco-Roman antiquities such as Pompey's Pillar and [the Catacombs of Kom El Shoqafa](#), as well as the massive Citadel of Qaitbay, which overlooks the Mediterranean Sea.

Day 1: Arrive Cairo, Check-In

When you arrive at Cairo International Airport, you will be greeted by a Cairo Top Tours tour leader who will transport you to your Cairo hotel and assist you with the check-in procedures, itinerary will be revised to confirm all pick-up times and if you would like to add any optional excursions in Egypt during your [Egypt tours](#) and Egypt desert safari adventure.

Day 2: Giza Pyramids Tour, Saqqara Necropolis, Memphis City

After your breakfast at the hotel, our tour guide will meet you to guide you through your Cairo day trips, beginning with the exciting tour to [Giza Pyramids](#), where you will be surprised by the size of these gigantic buildings constructed during Egypt's ancient history by the greatest kings and rulers.

Visit the Great Pyramid of Cheops, who was influenced by his father's difficult attempts to create extensive burial tombs, King Snefru, the founder of the 4th dynasty and the owner of two great pyramids in Dahshur, and continue to the high plateau for a spectacular panorama of the three pyramids, including the pyramids of Chephren, the son of Cheops and the successor of King Djedefre, who made his pyramid slightly smaller than his father's.

After taking an optional camel ride on the Giza Pyramids plateau, you will see the Great Sphinx in Giza, which is a statue of a man with the body of a lion that is believed to have been made for King Chephren himself for being within his funerary complex, enter the Valley Temple where the king's mummification process took place as part of the burial process.

Saqqara tours are now your next stop to visit the Step Pyramid, the first pyramid made entirely of stone by monarch Djoser, the second monarch of the third dynasty, the pyramid is located in the Saqqara Necropolis and is regarded a significant stage in the growth of pyramids in Egypt. You will also visit one of the site's pyramids, the pyramid of King Teti from the sixth dynasty, and one of the nobles' tombs built for the king's son-in-law, the tomb of Kagemni, who was the vizier of Justice during King Teti's reign.

Continue your tour in Cairo by traveling to the ancient city of Memphis, where you will view the open-air museum with the alabaster sphinx and the massive statue of King Ramses II, who governed Egypt during the New Kingdom era.

Before being driven back to the hotel, you will have a delicious lunch at a high-quality restaurant overlooking the pyramids and the Sphinx.

Day 3: Egyptian Museum, Coptic Cairo Tour, Khan El-Khalili

After breakfast at the hotel, you will meet your tour guide to begin your trip in Cairo with a tour of the Egyptian Museum to see the world's largest collection of Egyptian antiquities. After your 2 hour tour, you will transfer to the Coptic Cairo area to see Christian heritage such as the Hanging Church of the Holy Virgin Mary, which was built upon two towers of the ancient Roman fortress of Babylon, and the Church of St. Sergiu. Enjoy a delicious lunch before being transferred to the [Islamic Cairo](#) tour neighborhood in Khan El Khalili to enjoy the greatest walking tours in Cairo and get up close and personal with the Egyptian people. After your Cairo City Tour, you will be transferred back to your hotel for the night.

Day 4: Cairo to Alexandria Day Trip

Prepare to meet your expert tour guide after your excellent breakfast at the hotel to begin your day tour to Alexandria from Cairo with our Best Egypt Wheelchair Accessible Tours. You will be driven to Alexandria in an air-conditioned vehicle. The trip takes about 2.5 hours to complete, including a rest stop along the route.

When you arrive in Alexandria, the city founded by the Macedonian-origin ruler Alexander the Great in 332 B.C., you will begin your tour at Pompey's Pillar, then proceed to the Catacombs of Kom El Shoqafa, and finally to the Citadel of Qaitbay, which was built on the ruins of the ancient Lighthouse Pharos of Alexandria, one of the world's seven wonders.

Visit the [Bibliotheca Alexandria](#), a restoration of an ancient library that no longer exists. Ptolemy I built the library in the third century B.C. to serve as the world's hub of science and knowledge.

Enjoy a delicious seafood lunch at one of the city's best quality restaurants overlooking the port before being transferred to your Alexandria hotel for check-in and sleep.

Day 5: Alexandria to Alamein, Siwa Oasis

We will travel to [Siwa Oasis](#) for 7 hours after having breakfast and checking out of the hotel. On our way to the beautiful Siwa Oasis, we will stop in the Alamein area to experience El Alamein tours beginning with the Military Museum and the Commonwealth Alamein Cemetery of World War II to see army models and learn about the history of the main battle that occurred in Alamein during WWII. We will now go to the lovely city of Marsa Matrouh for a delicious lunch before continuing our tour to Siwa Oasis. We will leave our luggage at the eco-lodge and transfer to one of Egypt's most beautiful natural hot water springs to relax our muscles after a long day of driving. Back to the motel to sleep.

Day 6: Siwa Sightseeing Tours

Enjoy your Egyptian cuisine breakfast in the Eco-lodge before beginning our [Egypt Desert Safari Tours](#), which include viewing the ruins of the Shali Fortress, where the ancient Siwan people sought safety from foreign raids. Then, you will be transferred to visit the Temple of The Oracle at Aghurmi Village, which dates back to the 26th dynasty, as well as the Temple of Um Ubeyda, which is dedicated to the worship of God Amun Ra. Finally, you will be introduced to the valuable Siwan heritage through a visit to the Siwa House Museum, and lunch will be served at one of the Oasis' beautiful restaurants. You will spend the afternoon relaxing at Cleopatra Spring, one of the most famous hot water springs in Siwa Oasis that is thought to have been used by the last pharaoh, Queen Cleopatra, swimming and dipping into the glittering water before being transferred to Fitnas Island to enjoy the charming Sunset view.

Day 7: Egypt Desert Safari Tour to the Great Sand Sea

After a delicious breakfast at the hotel, your licensed tour guide will transport you in a 4x4 vehicle to explore the Great Sand Sea on your Siwa Oasis Desert Safari.

We will begin our [Egypt Desert Safari](#) journey by visiting the Mountain of the Dead and seeing many of the tombs of the oasis' rulers before moving on to the gorgeous sand dunes until we reach the Cambrian era fossils to see the aged corals. Then we will take you to one of the most incredible sites in the great sand sea, a beautiful lake in the heart of the desert, where you may be lucky enough to see flamingo birds swimming in the cold water of the lake, appreciating the serenity of the desert and bathing in a very relaxing mood. After passing by the Dakroul Mountain, we will enjoy sandboarding, the thrill of sliding down sand dunes instead of snow. After snowboarding, it is time to wash up in the hot spring known as Bir Wahid for chilling and soothing our muscles, and then enjoy another breathtaking sunset in the middle of the dunes while drinking Bedouin tea. Night in Siwa.

Day 8: Back to Cairo

You will receive your breakfast in the morning to begin your trip to Cairo from Siwa Oasis via Marsa Matrouh. When you arrive in Cairo, you will be taken to your hotel for the night. If you're lucky, and we arrived in Cairo earlier than usual, you can schedule one of the things to do in Cairo by night, such as having an optional amusing [Nile cruise dinner](#) in Cairo while witnessing an entertainment belly dancing and Tanoura dance show aboard a sailing boat on the Nile River.
