Day 1: Arrive Cairo / Check-in / Overnight

Welcoming to Cairo!

In order to begin your amazing Egypt tours, our Cairo Top Tours representative will meet you at <u>Cairo International Airport</u>, assist you with the airport security procedures, and then drive you in a private vehicle to the Giza hotel. Once there, our tour guide will assist you with the check-in process as quickly and easily as possible. She will also go over your Egypt Travel Packages schedule with you to make sure that all pick-up times are suitable for the two of you.

Hotel stay the night in Cairo.

You can stroll around the city, but make sure to get some rest so you're prepared for tomorrow's full day of sightseeing!

Day 2: Giza Pyramids Tour / Egyptian Museum Tour / Old Cairo Tour

After breakfast, you will be met at the hotel by your English-speaking tour guide to start your tour of the <u>Giza Pyramids</u>. Two of the world's oldest wonders, the Great Pyramid of <u>King Cheops</u> and the Middle Pyramid of his son <u>Chephren</u>, are among the pyramids of Giza. The Great Sphinx and the King Chephren Valley Temple are also nearby.

You will then be transferred to the <u>Egyptian Museum</u>, which is considered the oldest archaeological museum in the Middle East and includes the greatest antiquities in the world from the pre-dynastic era to the Greco-Roman era. We also have in the Egyptian Museum a statue of <u>Mentuhotep II</u>, which is one of the most wonderful exhibits of the Middle Kingdom. Tutankhamun's room is one of the Egyptian treasures from the Egyptian Museum in Cairo, and it will be completely transferred from the Egyptian Museum to the Grand Egyptian Museum, which will be the most important tourist attraction on Egypt tours.

After that, we'll take you on another tour to <u>Coptic Cairo</u>, where you can see the <u>Hanging Church</u> rising above the Roman fort's towers and the <u>Roman Citadel of Babylon</u>. You will then go to <u>Ben Ezra Synagogue</u> and Abu Sarja Church.

At one of Cairo's most famous restaurants, savor a traditional Egyptian lunch. To get to know Islamic Cairo, we will visit some of Cairo's famous mosques after lunch, such as the <u>Ibn Tulun Mosque</u> and the Fatimid Khan al-Khalili. before returning to the hotel, we will take a tour of the 600-year-old <u>Khan Al-Khalili</u> Market, one of Cairo's oldest markets, to buy souvenirs.

Day 3: East Bank of Luxor Tour

Breakfast in the hotel Following that, get ready to leave your Cairo hotel and be taken to Cairo International Airport for a domestic flight to Luxor, where a representative of our company will meet you. Join our five-star Egyptian Nile cruise, which departs from Luxor and arrives in Aswan. After lunch on board the cruise

ship, the <u>East Bank tours in Luxor</u> begin with a visit to the magnificent <u>Luxor Temple</u>. The eastern bank of the Luxor River is where the Luxor Temple Complex is situated (the ancient Thebes). It was established in 1400 BC for Amun-Ra worship, and Mut, his wife, constructed the Luxor Temple. It is one of the most preserved and beautiful temples in Egypt and can be seen clearly in the Egyptian temple.

In addition, Luxor Temple is one of the most important ancient Egyptian temples, as it highlights many important Pharaonic events in ancient hieroglyphics. It is considered one of the most important evidences of the immortality of the Pharaonic civilization.

Day 4: West Bank of Luxor/ Edfu

Next, you will have a visit to <u>Queen Hatshepsut's temple</u>, also known as <u>El</u> <u>Deir El Bahari's temple</u>. It is actually considered one of the most prominent temples in Egypt.

Then, have lunch at a local restaurant before boarding your bus for <u>Edfu</u>. which is a small Egyptian city located on the west bank of the Nile River between ancient Thebes and present-day Luxor and Aswan. It is considered one of the most beautiful temples in all of Egypt, where you can learn about how the god Horus defeated the god Set and how good triumphed over evil.
