Day 1 : Arrive Cairo / Check-in

When you arrive at [Cairo International Airport](#), our tour guide will be there to assist you with the arrival process and take you in a private vehicle to start your amazing tour of Egypt.

You will be welcomed with a welcome drink at the Cairo hotel when you arrive. Following this, our tour manager will help you check in quickly and easily and go over the itinerary for your Egypt travel packages with you to make sure all of the pick-up times work for you both.

Overnight in a Cairo hotel

Day 2: (Giza Pyramids Tour / Egyptian Museum Tour / Old Cairo Tour)

After breakfast at your five-star hotel on the second day of your trip, you'll be taken to see one of the seven wonders of the world.

With [the Egyptian Museum](#) originating in the 1800s, [the Giza Pyramids](#) are a globally recognized marvel. The Amr Ibn Al-Aas Mosque, which is part of the Old Cairo Tour, is a noteworthy African landmark. A worldwide Christian shrine called [the Hanging Church](#) is also located in the neighborhood.

Day 3:(Alexandria / Pompey's Pillar / Citadel of Qaitbay /Kom El Shoqafa / Bibliotheca of Alexandria)

Our transfer service ensures a hassle-free [Alexandria](#) tour from Cairo, taking you to your hotel in a comfortable, air-conditioned vehicle. The day includes stops at the Roman temple pillar, [the Citadel of Qaitbay](#), the catacombs of Kom El Shoqafa, and [the Bibliotheca of Alexandria](#). After enjoying a delicious lunch at a high-quality restaurant, you'll be transferred back to Cairo and have a break before returning to Cairo.

Day 4: Free Day

Have a free day in Cairo before you go on board the Nile cruise the next day.

Day 5: (check-in Luxor East Bank tour)

You will take a private vehicle to the airport in order to catch your flight to [Luxor](#). When you arrive, your first stop will be the magnificent ruins at Luxor International Airport.

Known for its famous statues, [the Luxor Temple](#) is a well-liked tourist attraction situated south of [the Karnak Temple](#). Three kilometers away is [the Valley of the Kings](#) on the western bank of the Nile. The nine-year-old pharaoh Tutankhamun ruled ancient Egypt during a time of change. He wanted to create a single image of all the gods.

If you book now, you'll be transferred to the Nile Cruise and enjoy a delicious dinner.

Day meals: breakfast, lunch, and dinner.

Day 6: (West Bank of Luxor/ Edfu)

On the 13th day of your Luxury Package tour, visit Luxor's notable sights, including the Memnon statue, King Amenhotep III's funerary temple, the unique [Temple of Hatshepsut](#), and the Karnak Temple. Enjoy delicious lunch and dinner, and enjoy activities during the evening. Optional hot air balloon ride in Luxor is available.

Day 7: (The temple of Edfu / the temple of Kom Ombo)

[Kom Ombo](#) is home to the oldest pottery workshop dating back to the Egyptian Fourth Dynasty. Enjoy a relaxing lunch on the Nile cruise ship before enjoying a Nubian animal show.

Day 8: (Aswan sightseeing)

Starting your day in [Aswan](#), visit [the High Dam](#), a rubble dam on the Nile River, and [the unfinished Obelisk](#), an ancient Egyptian architectural monument. The dam is crucial for the Egyptian water supply and maintains the river's stability. Enjoy a delicious dinner and a comfortable overnight stay aboard the ship.

Day Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner

Day 9: (Disembarkation - Going back to Cairo)

The final sightseeing trip of the Egypt Nile Cruise Tours includes visiting [the Abu Simbel](#) temples in Aswan, a popular tourist destination. Built by King Ramses II, these intricately carved monuments showcase ancient Egyptian artistry. After breakfast, you'll be transferred to [Aswan Airport](#) for your return flight to Cairo, followed by a flight to Amman.

Day 10: (Nebo Mount / Dead Sea)

After breakfast, you'll visit Nebo Mount, named after the god Naba, and the city of Nebo, which was abandoned after wars. The city was rebuilt by a Christian Bedouin tribe in the fourth century AD. The Dead Sea, a famous salt lake, is the lowest point on Earth, with crystal-clear water and stunning beaches.

Day meals: breakfast.

Day 11: (Petra tour)

Following breakfast, you will be taken to the Tetra Tree Hotel to complete your check-in at the start of the day.

Next, pay a visit to Petra. Although the Nabataeans are credited with building it, the Edomites were at war with their neighbors long before the Nabataeans settled in this region. Humans lived in the hills surrounding Petra between 1200 and 539 BC.

Spend the night at Petra.
