Day 1: arrival

When you arrive, our tour guide will pick you up from the airport in a cool, chauffeur-driven vehicle and take you straight to your Cairo hotel, taking care of all the check-in formalities.

Day 2: Giza and Dahshour Necropolises

We will pick you up at your hotel and take you on a tour of [the Giza Necropolis](#). In the morning, we will explore [the Valley Temple of King Chephren](#), the Great Sphinx of Giza, and the three Great Pyramids. We'll take a break in a neighborhood eatery after lunch before continuing our tour to [Dahshor](#) to explore its enormous cemeteries.

And at the end of the day, we will return you to your hotel!

Day 3: the National museum of Egyptian Civilisation and islamic Cairo

You will visit the New National Museum of Egyptian Civilization in Fustat in the morning and take an enlightening tour of its various halls. Your tour guide, who speaks English, will provide you with fresh perspectives on Egyptian history and culture.

We will depart from the National Museum and have lunch at a nearby restaurant before traveling to Islamic Cairo to visit the Sultan Hassan and Al-Refai mosques. In order to discover the fascinating details of the Mamluke architecture, we will go on a tour of their enormous worship halls.

Day 4: temple of Al-Karnak and Luxor

You will travel to Cairo airport on the fourth day in order to catch your domestic flight to [Luxor](#). Your tour guide will be waiting for you there to take you to Karnak so you can visit its three main temples. You will visit [the Luxor Museum](#) later that day to view the artwork created by the ancient Egyptians. When the day is over, you'll head back to your Luxor hotel.

Day 5: the Valley of the Queens and the Valley of the Kings (Wadi El Melouk Wal Malekat)

Today, you will set out from your Luxor hotel and head to Wadi El Melouk Wal Malekat, also known as the Valley of the Queens and [Valley of the Kings](#), where you will discover more about the 62 Pharaohs buried there. You will visit [the Colossi of Memnon](#) and the Deir Bahary cache after lunch.

Day 6: Edfou and Komombo temples

Our sixth day in Egypt will take us to [the Edfou Temple](#), which is midway between Luxor and Aswan. It is regarded as one of the best-preserved temples in all of Egypt, and the fascinating [Komombo temple](#) was once home to the worship of two gods, Horus and Sobek.

Day 7: High Dam and the Nubian village in Aswan

Our certified English-speaking tour guide will accompany us on the seventh day of our luxury tour packages as we spend the entire day at the most popular sites in Aswan: [The High Dam](#), one of the largest embankment dams in the world, and [the Nubian Village](#), where you can discover the Nubian culture and learn about its customs.

Day 8: back to Cairo

After picking you up from your Luxor hotel, we'll take you on a free day tour so you can see and do anything you want to in Cairo or Giza.

Day 9: Fayoum day tour

We will visit [the Valley of the Whales](#) (Wadi Al-Hitan) in Fayoum on your ninth day with us, where we hope to discover fossils dating back 40 million years. After that, we'll make our way to Wadi El-Rayan to visit El-Rayan Falls. Eventually, we'll head back to your Cairo hotel.

Day 10: Wahat Bahareiya And the white desert

We will drive north from your Cairo hotel to El-Wahat Al-Bahareya and the fascinating white desert in the Western Desert region, just north of the town of [Farafra Oasis](#). We'll head back to the Cairo hotel at the end of the day.

Day 11: back to Cairo

Tomorrow is your entire day to spend exploring Cairo at your own pace!

Day 12: moving to Ain-Sokhna

On the twelfth day, a representative from Cairo Top Tours will promptly collect you from your hotel and take you to your lodging at the Stella Di Marry hotel, allowing you to depart Cairo. You have the remainder of the day to yourself.
