Day 4: Travel To Luxor and The East Bank

Originally known as Bar-Amun, the Karnak Temple is a well-known Apt Sot temple in Egypt. Once you've had time to take in its splendor, stop and rest before moving on to the next phase, which involves lunch on a Nile cruise. Theban Trinity gods reside in the Luxor Temple, which dates back more than 4,000 years.

An open courtyard, an edifice, and two obelisks are features of the Luxor Temple, a historic site that dates back to the kings of the eighteenth and nineteenth dynasties. It is now a well-liked tourist destination because of the remarkable work done by previous rulers. The temple, sometimes referred to as "Ibet-Reset," is one of the best-preserved Egyptian temples and is a house of worship devoted to Amun-Ra.

Day 5: Travel To The West Bank

Day 6: Visit Edfu and Komombo Temples

After breakfast, you should definitely visit the opulent <u>Edfu Temple</u>, an ancient Egyptian temple. Two local gods, Horus and Komombo, live in harmony at <u>the Komombo Temple</u>, a singular location, despite having different ancestries and personalities. Its distinct architectural element distinguishes it from other Ptolemaic Egyptian temples, providing guests with an intriguing and one-of-a-kind experience.

Additionally, you'll visit the incomplete obelisk monument in Aswan, Egypt, which would have reached 7 meters in height and 1168 tons in weight.

Day 9: Fayum Day Tour

After breakfast, visit the Abu Simble Temple, an archaeological site on Lake Nasser's western bank. Located on a dome structure above the Aswan High Dam reservoir, it was originally carved during King Ramesses II's reign. After visiting, transfer to the airport for a flight to Cairo, then to a hotel.

Day 9: Fayum Day Tour

Start your day with an Egyptian breakfast and a tour guide to Fayoum, known for its Lake of Qarun and impressive architecture. Take a break for lunch before exploring the Wadi El Rayan Reserve in Fayoum Governorate. The reserve features upper and lower lakes, a waterfall, Uyun al Rayyan, Jabal al Rayan, and Mudawara mountain. It features sand dunes, natural springs, plant life, animals, and marine excavations, making it an ideal destination for a unique Egyptian experience.
