Day 1: Arrival in Egypt

Upon landing at Cairo [International Airport](#), you'll receive a warm reception from our dedicated tour leader. They will assist you with all customs procedures, ensuring a smooth and hassle-free arrival experience. Your comfort is our priority, and we provide a private air-conditioned vehicle specifically designed for individuals with mobility challenges.

Your Cairo and Luxor Accessible [Tour Package](#) will then be reviewed to guarantee that you fully enjoy your 5-day Egypt Accessible Tour. After your arrival, you'll be transferred to your hotel to spend the night there.

Relax and unwind as you settle in, and savour a welcome drink, marking the start of your incredible journey in Egypt.

Day 2: Giza Pyramids and the Egyptian Museum

Begin your day with a delightful breakfast at the hotel. Our dedicated representative will meet you, and an experienced Egyptologist guide will accompany you on your Cairo adventure.

Your tour will start with a visit to the iconic Giza Pyramids, where you'll explore the renowned three Pyramids and the Great Sphinx, and then you will be transferred to [the Egyptian Museum tour](#). Marvel at the impressive Great Sphinx, which dates back to the time of King Chephren (2620 B.C). Additionally, you'll visit the [Valley of Temples](#), historically used for the mummification of the king.

A satisfying lunch will be served in a high-quality restaurant, fueling you for the next leg of your journey a visit to the Egyptian Museum. This remarkable institution boasts a vast collection of archaeological treasures. Among the numerous artifacts, you'll encounter the priceless collection of King Tutankhamen, a one-of-a-kind ivory statue of the great King Cheops, measuring only 7 cm in length, and a granite statue of Queen Hatshepsut, along with over 120,000 artifacts spanning [Cairo day trips](#) ancient history from the Paleolithic era to the Greco-Roman period.

After a day filled with exploration, you'll be transferred back to your hotel, where you'll have the option to enhance your experience with a delightful Cairo Nile cruise dinner. While on board, you can enjoy the captivating entertainment of an oriental Tanoura Dance Show. (Optional tour)

Day 3: Fly to Luxor, West Bank Tours

Breakfast at the hotel before our representative assists you through the check-out procedures. Transfer to Cairo airport, according to the departure of the flight to Luxor. Upon arrival at Luxor Airport, you will meet your tour leader and tour guide to start Luxor West Bank tours where the Valley of the Kings is located. The Valley of the Kings was a necropolis for the kings and rulers of ancient Egypt during the new kingdom, here between silence, desert, and sky you will have a charming experience by visiting 3 of the royal tombs. You will continue your [Luxor excursions](#) by visiting the Temple of Hatshepsut which was built by Senmut, her loyal architect, and the Colossi of Memnon. Our tour guide will explain to you how these immense statues used to be inside the temple of [Amenhotep III](#). You will enjoy your lunch in a good quality restaurant, then we will transfer you to your hotel in Luxor to spend the night there.

Day 4: Luxor East Bank Tours

Breakfast will be served at the hotel then start Luxor east bank tours by visiting the Karnak Temple which is a complex of temples, sacred lakes, Obelisks, chapels, and avenues, it has been written that its greatness made it the center of religion in ancient Egypt during the new kingdom. You will have a tasty lunch in a restaurant during your [sightseeing tours in Luxor](#). You will visit Luxor Temple which is dedicated to God Amun, a building located on the eastern bank of the Nile, was built by Amenhotep III during the [eighteenth dynasty](#) and completed by the famous King Ramses II, at the same time as the construction of the temple of Karnak, to which it is connected by an avenue flanked by sphinxes. We will transfer you to Luxor Airport for the flight back to Cairo, and you will meet our representative at Cairo airport, who will transfer you to your hotel.

Day 5: Final Departure
