Itinerario

Day 1: Arrival to Cairo and check in

The tour guide from Cairo Top Tours will be waiting to welcome you when you arrive at <u>Cairo International Airport</u> with a signboard carrying your name. He will provide comfortable, air-conditioned transportation to get you to your Giza lodging. Prior to arriving, double-check all pick-up times on the itinerary for your <u>Egypt Classic Tours</u> from Cairo to Alexandria trip so that our representative can assist you with a speedy check-in.

Day 2: Pyramids Sightseeing Tour

After a delightful breakfast at your luxurious Cairo hotel, get ready for an awe-inspiring day of exploring the ancient wonders of Egypt, starting with the Giza Pyramids and the enigmatic Sphinx.

Your adventure from our <u>Cairo Day Tours</u> begins with a visit to the largest and most famous pyramid in Egypt, the <u>Great Pyramid of Khufu</u>. Adjacent to the pyramids stands <u>the Great Sphinx</u>, a colossal statue with the body of a lion and the head of a pharaoh.

Upon arrival in Alexandria, your first stop from our <u>Alexandria Day Tours</u> will be the modern architectural wonder, <u>the Bibliotheca Alexandrina</u>. Explore this magnificent library, which is a tribute to the ancient Library of Alexandria

Enjoy a seafood-themed lunch at a renowned local restaurant by the seaside. Alexandria is famous for its fresh seafood dishes, and this meal will be a true culinary delight.

Your fourth day in Egypt brings you back to Cairo to explore its cultural gems, including the Egyptian Museum, Islamic and Coptic Cairo, and a dinner cruise on the Nile, ensuring a blend of history and modern elegance.

Begin your day with a delightful breakfast at your Hotel in Alexandria before checking out. Upon returning to Cairo, visit the world-renowned <u>Egyptian Museum</u>. Marvel at the extensive collection of artifacts from ancient Egypt, including the treasures of King Tutankhamun.

Enjoy a gourmet lunch at a well-regarded restaurant in downtown Cairo, that offers both international and Egyptian cuisine.

Explore the historic district of <u>Islamic Cairo</u>, home to some of the city's most iconic landmarks. Visit the <u>Citadel of Salah El Din</u>, an imposing fortress offering panoramic views of the city, and the stunning <u>Sultan Hassan Complex</u>, known for its intricate Mamluk architecture. Finally, discover <u>the Mohamed Ali Alabaster Mosque</u>, which is claimed to be the only example of Ottoman architecture in Egypt.

Our tour of Coptic Cairo includes a trip to the <u>Hanging Church</u> of the Blessed Virgin Mary, commonly known as Al Mualaka or the hanging church because it was built above the fortress's towers.

Our Egypt day tours also include a visit to the <u>Ben Ezra Synagogue</u>, which was allegedly built where baby Moses' basket was found. The holy family resided here for three months, getting their water from the vault above the synagogue.

Before continuing our tours of Islamic Cairo to the <u>Khan El Khalili</u> market, which is situated in the heart of Cairo's Islamic Middle Ages, we will pause for a delicious lunch. In this area, one can view the medieval Cairo walls and gates in addition to the tunnels from the 10th century.

Once you return to Cairo, our agent will take you to your hotel for the night.

Day 5: The White Desert and Bahariya Oasis Overnight from Cairo

On this day, your adventure takes a thrilling turn as you depart from Cairo for a unique and enchanting journey to the surreal landscapes of Bahariya Oasis and an overnight stay in the White Desert.

Start your day with a delicious breakfast at your Cairo hotel. a private driver and desert guide will pick you up from your hotel early in the morning. Make sure to pack essentials such as comfortable clothing, sunscreen, sunglasses, and a hat for the desert adventure.

Begin your road trip to the <u>Bahariya Oasis</u>, which is approximately a 4-5 hour drive from Cairo. Along the way, you'll witness the changing landscapes from the urban environment of Cairo to the serene desert scenery.

Enjoy a picnic lunch amidst the desert landscapes or have lunch at a local restaurant in Bahariya.

We will visit the Golden Mummies, the largest cemetery in Egypt dating back to the Greco-Roman era. then head to the Alexander the Great Temple Ruins, and Tombs of the Nobles at Bahariya Oasis, which are important burial sites dating to the 26th dynasty of Egyptian history and include the tomb of Bannantiu in the Western Desert of Egypt.

Then, you'll depart for the White Desert to tour the Valley of El Haize, south of the oasis, after a sumptuous lunch at an eatery designed to resemble an oasis. During this break, you can take a quick dip in the warm spring. In the Black Desert, where the mountains have slowly been eaten away by natural processes to cover the desert with a coating of black rocky dust, one can travel to the hamlet, a paradise in the heart of the desert.

Take a stop to enjoy the shapes of the lovely <u>Crystal Mountain</u> and the spectacular <u>Valley of Agabat</u> as you travel between the Bahariya and Farafra Oasis, adjacent to the Crystal Mountain and the White Desert.

We will enjoy camping in the White Desert, where there is a great chance to see an amazing sunset, while your local guides prepare your lunch.

Take in the stunning stars while you're sleeping at the camp.

Day 6: White Desert Back to Bahariya Oasis

You will enjoy an organic local breakfast in the White Desert as part of your Cairo Excursions today while you take in the stunning surroundings. When you continue your day tours from Cairo, you will come across the magnificent white limestone stones that gave the white desert its name.

Then, you'll be taken to Cairo over the Black Desert. In Bahariya Oasis, we take a pause to take in the beautiful sand dunes, salt lakes, and fruit orchards. The two-day journey from Cairo to the White Desert and the Bahariya Oasis will come to an end. We have around four hours to travel back to the hotel in Cairo.

Day 7: The end of your Egypt tours packages from Cairo

Enjoy your final breakfast while touring Egypt. A tour guide from one of Egypt's top tours will pick you up after you check out and drive you to Cairo International Airport for your final departure.
