Day 1: Arrival to Cairo airport

Our representative will meet you at <u>Cairo International Airport</u> bearing a sign bearing your name and the Cairo Top Tours logo. From the airport, an elegant vehicle will transport you to the Cairo hotel. After helping you quickly check into the hotel, the Cairo Top Tours representative will meet with you to go over your itinerary and give you all of the pick-up times for your excursions in Cairo while you are on vacation in Egypt.

Day2: Tour to Giza Pyramids and Saqqara

After breakfast, you will be picked up by our tour guide and driven to the magnificent <u>Giza pyramids</u>. In addition to admiring the Great Pyramid of King Cheops, one of the Seven Wonders of the World, you can set out on an expedition and explore it while you're there. You will visit also the <u>Great Sphinx</u> that watches over the Pyramids.

Then we switch buses and head to the <u>Saqqara Necropolis</u>. Visit the Red and <u>Bent Pyramid</u> in Dahshour, which was constructed by King Sinfru, Cheops' father. Discover the errors that the Egyptians made when constructing the pyramids.

After that, grab a bite to eat nearby before going back to your hotel.

Our tour guide will be waiting for you in an air-conditioned car when we pick you up from your hotel. We will start our day by visiting The National Museum of Egyptian Civilisation (NEMC). It is acknowledged as the first museum in the world to provide a thorough portrait of Egyptian civilization throughout its history, from prehistory to the present.

After that, we'll move on to Citadel Square. We'll visit the <u>Sultan Hassan Mosque</u>, a magnificent Mamluke building constructed in 1359.

At the end of the day, a driver will drive you back to your hotel.

Day 4: Boarding to Luxor

Our local staff will meet you and assist you at the <u>Luxor airport</u> at the morning before you transfer to the Nile Cruise. Take your delightful Lunch on the cruise while enjoying the beautiful scenery.

You'll have a visit to the <u>Karnak Temple</u>, which is the largest and one of the most important temples in Egypt, and <u>Luxor Temple</u>, one of the most significant and well-preserved temples in Egypt and was dedicated to the gods Amun, Mut, and Chons.

After that, Discover the <u>Obelisks of Queen Hatshepsut</u>, It was made of Silestone to honor the accomplishments of the great Queen Hatshepsut, then proceed to <u>the Temple Of Thutmose III</u>, The temple was built to honor and commemorate Pharaoh Thutmose III and serve as a place of worship and offerings for the gods.

Finally, you will enjoy on the cruise a Belly Dance performance and dinner.

Luxor overnight on board

Day 5: Sail to the West Bank to Esna.

Take Breakfast on board, then begin your to The West Bank of Luxor, which is home to the Valley of the Kings, the Colossi of Memnon, and the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut at El Deir El Bahari. visit to the Valley of Kings; see Deir El Bahari's temple and the tombs of many dynasties.

On the way back, pause at the Colossi of Memnon, two enormous statues of Amenophis III that are seated and facing the Nile.

Visit the Queen Hatshepsut Mortuary Temple following that. Hatshepsut, a pharaoh of the Eighteenth Dynasty who died in 1458 BC, had the temple at Deir el-Bahari on the west bank of the Nile near the <u>Valley</u> of the Kings constructed for her. served aboard for lunch. Then travel to Esna.

A Night on the Boat

Day 6: Sail to Edfu to Kom Ombo

Start your day with a delicious breakfast on board as you enjoy the scenic views along the Nile.

After breakfast, disembark from your cruise ship and head to the Temple of Horus in Edfu, one of the best-preserved temples in Aswan. Explore this magnificent temple dedicated to the falcon-headed god Horus, and marvel at the intricate hieroglyphs and towering statues.

Return to your cruise ship for lunch as it prepares to set sail for Kom Ombo.

Arrive in Kom Ombo in the late afternoon. Visit the unique Kom Ombo Temple, dedicated to both the crocodile god Sobek and the falcon god Horus. Explore the temple's double design, with duplicate chambers and halls for each deity.

Return to your cruise ship for a delicious dinner. You can enjoy your meal on the deck, and enjoy the tranquil atmosphere of the Nile at night.

Day 7: Continue your Aswan Tour

Start your day with a hearty breakfast on your cruise ship as it docks in Aswan.

After breakfast, embark on a visit to <u>the High Dam</u>. This engineering marvel was built in the 1960s to control the annual flooding of the Nile River. Learn about its significance to Egypt's development and take in panoramic views of <u>Lake Nasser</u> from the dam.

Explore the beautifully preserved <u>Temple of Philae</u>, dedicated to the goddess Isis. Admire the intricate carvings and columns of this island temple, which was relocated and saved from the rising waters of Lake Nasser during the construction of the High Dam.

Enjoy a delicious lunch, either back on your cruise ship or at a local restaurant in Aswan, depending on your tour arrangements.

Visit the famous <u>Unfinished Obelisk</u>, an ancient quarry site where you can see the massive obelisk that was abandoned during its construction.

Enjoy a delectable dinner on board, savoring the flavors of Egyptian cuisine as you share your experiences with fellow travelers.

Day 8: Disembarkation

Day 9: Day use in Fayoum

To begin your day's journey to Fayoum, a knowledgeable tour guide from <u>Cairo Top Tours</u> will pick you up from your hotel in Cairo. From there, you can begin your visits.pyramid of Lahoun

The 48-meter-long pyramid is located in the Fayoum Governorate. The pyramid's centre core is made completely of granite chunks and is constructed on top of a tall hill. There are passages that lead to the chamber where King Senusret II was interred beneath the pyramid.

The Pyramid of Hawara wich was One of Egypt's pyramids is the Hawara pyramid. It was constructed in the town of Hawara, 9 kilometres southeast of the city of Faiyum, by Egyptian King Amenemhat III.

It is constructed out of limestone-coated bricks.

Museum Kom Oshim: Visitors to the museum can read the identifying panels for each exhibit item, study the artefacts that are on display, and enjoy a guided tour. The most notable archaeological relics, sculptures, and artefacts on display in Kom Oshim Museum include a collection of mummy portraits from the Ptolemaic colony of Karanis that were discovered in Fayoum.

You'll then sayour a delectable supper in an Asian restaurant.

After that, sail down the vast Nile River in a felucca.

After that, we will end our service and drive you to the drop-off point.

Day 10: From Cairo to Bahariya Oasis / White Desert

At 6:30 AM, your tour guide and driver will pick you up from your hotel in Cairo using a sign with your name on it and take you 350 km (about 4 hours) southwest to the Bahariya Oasis.

Once you arrive in Bahariya, change your car to a 4x4 and begin your day with lunch before visiting "<u>Al-Marsous Mountain</u>," one of the Black Desert's most famous mountains. It is a volcanic crater that is entirely covered in jasper from the eruption.

Next, proceed to the Bedouin village to witness <u>Crystal Mountain</u> and the Valley of Agabat's Cold Sulfur Water Well. It is a mountain full of diverse crystals, with more than 12 different varieties of crystals, making it one of the rarest mountains in the world.

In the Great Sand Sea, sandboarding Near Siwa, surf the enormous dunes of the Great Sand Sea. Considered to be the best dune surfing spot in the world, the desert has exceptionally smooth, steep dunes that reach heights of 140 meters.

The most well-known desert destination in Egypt is the White Desert National Park, and for good reason. Keep driving there. No other desert in the world has as many bizarre and stunning wind-carved rock formations shaped like enormous mushrooms, chickens, rabbits, or pebbles. Return to the Al Haiz campground for an overnight stay (sleep in a tent).

Day 11: Bahariya Oasis / Cairo

After breakfast at the campsite, visit Siwa's hot sulfur springs. Take a shower in a hotel, then eat lunch at the Bahariya Oasis before returning to Cairo around 5:00 p.m. Breakfast and lunch.

Day 12: Cairo to Sokhna

Check out of your hotel in Cairo after having breakfast. Ensure you have all your belongings packed and ready for the journey.

You can travel to <u>Sokhna</u> by private car, bus, or other means of transportation. The drive from Cairo to Sokhna typically takes around 2 to 3 hours, depending on traffic conditions and your starting point in Cairo.

Once you arrive in Sokhna, check in to your chosen accommodation then spend your afternoon enjoying the beautiful beaches of Sokhna. The Red Sea's clear waters and sandy shores provide an ideal setting for swimming, sunbathing, and water sports. Many resorts in Sokhna offer private beach access.

Savor a delicious dinner at your hotel's restaurant or explore Sokhna's dining options, which often feature fresh seafood and international cuisine.

Day 13: Snorkeling Trip

Start your day early by meeting your snorkeling tour guide or group at a designated meeting point in Sokhna. Ensure you have all the necessary snorkeling gear, including masks, snorkels, fins, and life jackets, which may be provided by the tour operator.

Hop aboard a comfortable boat or yacht that will take you to one of the pristine snorkeling spots along the Red Sea coast. The boat ride itself offers beautiful views of the coastline and the open sea.

At the end of this day, The tour guide from Cairo Top Tours will drive you back to your accommodation in Cairo from Ain Sokhna after the boat ride in a luxurious, air-conditioned car.
