## Day 1: Aswan Sightseeing

Upon arrival at <u>Aswan Airport</u> or the railway station, you'll be greeted by a Cairo Top Tours guide holding a signboard with your name. You'll then be transferred to the dock to begin your Aswan to Luxor Nile cruise. After check-in, enjoy a delicious open buffet lunch on board before starting your Aswan day tours.

Visit the High Dam, which saved Egypt from the constant floods of the Nile River, and explore the popular Granite Quarries where the ancient Egyptians quarried stones for their massive structures, including the Unfinished Obelisk. Take a motorboat to visit the Temple of Philae, devoted to the goddess Isis and built in the Greco-Roman style of architecture.

After finishing the Aswan Excursions, enjoy a lovely dinner aboard the cruise ship and a special Nubian folklore show for entertainment. Included meals: Welcome drink, lunch, and dinner.

#### Day 2: Kom Ombo and Edfu Temples

You will continue one of the most amazing Day Tours in Egypt, the Tour to Kom Ombo Temple and Edfu, after finishing your breakfast onboard your Egypt Nile River Cruise. The boat will head to the Kom Ombo Temple as it travels north. We will go to the Ptolemaic Temple, which was built in honor of the gods Sobek and Haroeris, a form of Horus that was revered in this area. Everyone will have enough time to explore the temple before your boat departs for Edfu and your delectable buffet lunch is provided.

After arriving at Edfu Temple, you will ride in a carriage to the ancient Horus Temple before boarding a boat and traveling to Esna while enjoying your afternoon tea. Another excellent dinner will be given on board in the evening. After returning from your tour of Edfu, you will spend the night aboard your Nile Cruise in Esna, where the entertainment will be a really remarkable Egyptian Galabeya Party.

Breakfast, lunch, afternoon tea, and dinner are all included.

#### Day 3: Luxor Sightseeing Tours

Enjoy a leisurely breakfast as the boat makes its way towards Luxor, then get ready for the West Bank of Luxor Tours, which many people see as the city's top attraction.

When you arrive in Luxor, you will disembark to begin your <u>Luxor day tours</u> and visit the rock-cut tombs of the <u>Valley of Kings</u>, which is famous throughout the world. Here, many New Kingdom kings and pharaohs are laid to rest, including Ramses the Great, Tutmosis, and the golden pharaoh Tutankhamen, whose tomb was discovered completely intact in the year 1922, which was one of the most successful excavations in <u>Egyptian history</u>. The beautiful <u>Temple of Hatshepsut</u>, one of Luxor's most well-known sites, will be your next stop. Before having another lunch on the cruise, you will be taken to view the historic <u>Colossi of</u>

Memnon, which was constructed for King Amenhotep III.

The <u>Luxor Temple</u> will be visited after the impressively well-preserved <u>Karnak Temples</u> as part of our ongoing Luxor sightseeing trips. After the incredible East and West Bank day trip, savor a hearty meal and spend one more night on the cruise ship.
