Day 1: Aswan Tours - sail to Edfu

A representative from Cairo Top Tours will meet you at the train station or the Aswan airport to transfer you to the Sunray Nile Cruise Aswan to Luxor, which departs from Aswan to Luxor every Monday.

Your Aswan day tour will first begin with a visit to the <u>High Dam</u>, which is the main source of electricity for the entire nation, and you will visit the <u>Unfinished Obelisk</u>. It is considered the largest obelisk in Egyptian history and was started by Queen Hatshepsut but unfortunately never completed.

Next, you will have a visit to the <u>Greco-Roman temple</u> constructed to honor one of the most remarkable gods in pre-dynastic <u>Egyptian religion</u>, the famous goddess Isis, Explore the magnificent <u>Philae Temple</u>. Then we leave to visit Kom Ombo and have dinner on board the Sunray Nile cruise ship as we travel from Aswan to Luxor.

Day 2: Edfu and Kom Ombo Temples - Sail to Luxor

In the early morning, you will arrive at Kom Ombo, where you will explore the enormous <u>Temple of Kom Ombo</u>, which is devoted to two gods and which your knowledgeable guide will describe in detail at the location.

Additionally, you will also enjoy the visit of the colorful local bazaars on your way where you can buy your souvenirs, and you can enjoy lunch during the trip to Edfu, as it is considered one of the most beautiful temples in all of Egypt and dates back to the Ptolemaic era.
