Day 1: Monday: Aswan Tours - Sail to Edfu

Day 2: Tuesday: Edfu and Kom Ombo Temples - Sail to Luxor

You will go to Kom Ombo in the early morning, where you will explore the enormous Temple of Kom Ombo that is devoted to the two deities, which your knowledgeable guide will describe in detail at the location. While traveling to Edfu to see one of the best-preserved temples in Egyptian history, you can also take in the colorful local markets where you can purchase gifts and have lunch. Take the horse-drawn carriage to the famed Temple of Edfu, one of Egypt's most stunning temples that dates back to the Ptolemaic era. The Temple of Edfu is one of Egypt's largest temples and is devoted to the god Horus.

Day 3: Wednesday: Luxor Sightseeing Tours

It will be time to begin <u>Luxor West Bank Tours</u> after breakfast by seeing the enormous necropolis known as the <u>Valley of the Kings</u>, where a number of ancient Egyptian pharaohs and nobles were interred in crypts carved out of the cliffs. Continue to take in the splendor of the <u>Luxor temple</u>, which serves as another illustration of the grandeur of the pharaohs and monarchs of the ancient Egyptian New Kingdom. Following supper, you can watch a belly

dancing performance. and stay in Luxor for the night.
