The quartzite crystals that compose the hill, which can be seen on the right, are what give it the nickname "the Jewel of the Desert" and give it its stunning appearance when illuminated by the sun. That natural feature was discovered by chance a few decades ago.

Then we'll go to the Bahariya Oasis and soak in the heat in the relaxing hot spring known as Bir Sigam. The spring is the best hot spring in terms of temperature and is situated on Cairo Road, 7 km east of Bahariya.

then make your way back to Cairo.

Day 5: Day Tour to El Fayoum

Embark on a captivating Day 5 with a tour to [El Fayoum](#), a hidden gem nestled southwest of Cairo. Immerse yourself in the rich tapestry of this oasis region, known for its breathtaking landscapes and cultural treasures.

Explore the serene shores of [Lake Qarun](#), Then move to [the Wadi Hitan](#) Protected Area, also known as the Valley of the Whales, which was recognized by UNESCO as a World Heritage Site and is situated inside the Wadi El Rayan Protected Area.

See Mudawara Mountain on the route to Wadi El Rayan Water Falls. then into the waterfalls of Wadi Al Ryan. The only waterfalls in Egypt may be found at [Wadi El Rayan](#), a natural depression in the western desert that was created in 1970 by the overflow of drainage water from the Fayoum farmlands.

At a high-caliber restaurant, a late lunch will be provided. Transfer back to Cairo after that.

Day 6: Tour to Alexandria ,Ancient Adventures

After breakfast, our tour leader will pick you up from your Cairo hotel to [Alexandria](#) in a modern and air-conditioned car, and check you in your the Paradise Inn Beach Resort.

You will tour the most important Greco-Roman remains in the city. Visit the Serapeum, a temple that houses [Pompey's Pillar](#), a red granite column, and then go below to the creepy [Catacombs of Kom el Shoqafa](#). then For a feast of seafood from the Mediterranean, visit the waterfront. Next, explore [the Citadel of Qaitbay](#), a marine fort constructed in the 15th century on the location of the historic [Lighthouse of Alexandria](#). The underwater archaeological exhibitions at the National Museum of Alexandria will transport you back in time to the ancient world.

Afterward, embark on a street food tour around the city to see the diverse world of Egyptian cuisine, which draws inspiration from Ottoman and Arab traditions. Along with kebabs, mixed grills, meze dips, and seafood, enjoy delicacies like koshary, a zesty concoction of lentils, noodles, and sour tomato sauce. Ice cream and sweet pastries to finish.

Day7 : Tour to Alexandria , Modern Magic
