Day 1: Arrival to Cairo and check in

A Cairo Top Tours representative will be waiting for you inside your terminal at <u>Cairo International Airport</u> with a sign that includes your name and the company name. To reach your accommodation in Cairo, you will be transferred by private air-conditioned car to the hotel. Check in at the hotel. Next, you will have a visit to <u>Queen Hatshepsut's temple</u>, also known as <u>El Deir El Bahari's temple</u>. It is actually considered one of the most prominent temples in Egypt.

Return to your cruise ship and spend the night there.

Day 6: Visit to The temple of Edfu / the temple of Kom Ombo

The Nile River Cruise will offer you an open buffet breakfast. Then, get ready as your knowledgeable Egyptologist guide leads you to the admirably preserved Edfu Ptolemaic-style temple, which is dedicated to God Horus, who in accordance with ancient Egyptian religion is the protector of royalty. Following your return to the ship, you are free to explore the Temple of Kom Ombo, which is dedicated to the crocodile gods Sobek and Haroeris. Enjoy your lunch, which is being provided to you, as the Nile cruise ship travels toward Aswan.

As you take in the Nubian Show and spend the night in Aswan on board your opulent Nile cruise, a delectable meal will be served.

Day 7: Aswan Tours

On board the boat, savor your delicious breakfast before you arrive in the lovely city of Aswan to see the renowned Aswan High Dam. This building was constructed to lessen the annual flooding of the Nile's deadly effects. We will take you by boat to the magnificent Temple of Philae, an island temple dedicated to the goddess Isis. The next largest known obelisk in the Aswan granite quarries is the unfinished obelisk, which was probably constructed by Queen Hatshepsut.

Keep observing the water wheels at Al Fayoum; they were crucial to the community's economy because they were used for agriculture. The water wheels serve as the official emblem of the governorate of El Fayoum today.

Visit <u>Lake Qarun</u>, one of the most renowned historic natural lakes, and the waterfalls of <u>Wadi Al Rayan</u>, where water sports, fishing, and bird watching are popular pastimes. After that, return to your Cairo accommodation by transfer.

Day 10: Fly to Sharm El Sheikh
