Day 1: Arrival in Egypt

After lunch, head to <u>the Egyptian Museum</u> in Cairo, home to one of the world's most extensive collections of ancient Egyptian artifacts. This accessible museum houses over 120,000 items, including the treasures of Tutankhamun.
