Day 1: Arrival in Egypt

Arrival in Cairo, the beginning of your Cairo and the Nile Cruise Accessible Tour from USA, our representative will meet you at <u>Cairo International Airport</u> to transfer you by a private air-conditioned vehicle to your hotel in Cairo. Overnight in Cairo after making sure all your pick-up times and any additional tours in Egypt are revised during your 8 Days Egypt Accessible Tour Package.

Day 2: Giza Pyramids, Egyptian Museum

After breakfast at the hotel, our tour guide meet you to start your tour in Cairo by visiting the highlights of Cairo one of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World, the tour to <u>Giza Pyramids</u> to see the gigantic structure known as the Great Pyramid of King Cheops, built during the <u>4th dynasty</u> of Egypt history, (4500 years ago) by the son of Snefru, Cheops from the old kingdom, by the efforts of almost 20 years of hard work to become the tallest building in the world until the construction of the Lincoln Cathedral in 1311 A.D.

The day is full of antiquities from the past with unforgettable visits to the <u>Valley Temple</u> of King Chephren, the Pyramid of Mycerinus, and the Great Sphinx.

After exploring the area of the Giza plateau, you will be transferred to Cairo downtown to start the Egyptian Museum tour, <u>the Egyptian Museum</u> houses more than 120,000 artifacts that will make you amazed by the elaborate perfection of ancient Egyptian art, see the most interesting golden collection of <u>King Tutankhamen</u> and discover the royal mummies room before being transferred to the restaurant for the delightful lunch meal, back to the hotel and overnight.

Day 3: Free Day at Leisure, Optional Alexandria Tour from Cairo

Enjoy your breakfast buffet at the hotel and spend the day at leisure on your own or have an optional day tour to Alexandria from Cairo to explore the <u>Greco-Roman</u> era ruins of the city that used to be the capital of Egypt during the 4th century B.C after the famous Alexander the Great founded it to compete with the Greek cities during that time.

Day 4: Fly to Aswan, Aswan Nile Cruise Tours

After your daily buffet breakfast in the early morning is done, you will meet our representative who will be responsible to transfer you to <u>Cairo international airport</u> to take your flight to Aswan, upon arrival at Aswan airport, you will be met by another representative to transfer you to the cruise ship and assist you with the check-in procedures, you will leave your luggage and start your Aswan excursions by the incredible visit to the Aswan <u>High Dam</u>, the great project which was done by the modern-Egyptian president Nasser in the 20th century to save the county from the annual Nile floods and generate electricity for every corner of Egypt.

Continue Aswan tours to the <u>Temple of Philae</u>, the Ptolemaic temple that was dedicated to the goddess of magic according to the ancient Egyptian religion, Goddess Isis. You will be moved to the granite quarries during your excursions in Aswan to see the Unfinished Obelisk that we believe to be cut during the reign of Queen Hatshepsut. Transfer back to the cruise ship and enjoy your lunch and dinner meals aboard the boat, overnight in Aswan.

Day 5: Kom Ombo and Edfu Temples

Breakfast aboard the vessel, while we comfortably continue our cruise on the Nile. The ship stops at Edfu to visit the great <u>Temple of Edfu</u>, dedicated to the falcon God Horus, the god of the sky and son of Osiris. Continue your tour to <u>Kom Ombo Temple</u> that was devoted to two of the ancient Egyptian gods, Sobek and Horaeris before being transferred back to the cruise ship, lunch, and dinner aboard the boat and overnight.

Day 6: Luxor East Bank Tours

After breakfast aboard the boat, we will arrive in Luxor, the largest open-air museum in the world, full of monuments from ancient civilizations. The Luxor area of ??Upper Egypt was the Thebes of the ancient Egyptians and the capital of Egypt during the Middle Kingdom and the New Kingdom. On the eastern bank is the modern city of Luxor <u>Luxor Temple</u>. At the northern end of the city is the vast <u>Karnak Temple</u> complex built approximately 4055 years ago. It is famous for its main hypostyle hall with its 134 massive columns. You can explore the ruins starting from the first pylon, you will have a journey back in time. By means of an avenue flanked by sphinxes on both sides, we will be visiting the Temple of Luxor, one of the biggest places for worship on earth built by King <u>Amenhotep III</u>. We will be back on the cruise ship after our Luxor east bank tours are done.

Day 7: Luxor West Bank Tours

After your delicious breakfast, you will disembark from your Aswan to Luxor Nile cruise and start your Luxor west bank tours beginning with <u>the Valley of the Kings</u>, the new kingdom necropolis where the excavations are still taking place, one of the most famous sites in Luxor where most of the tombs found intact without being touched. Continue Luxor excursions to <u>the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut</u> which was built to be the mortuary temple with the divine birth story of the semi-god Queen Hatshepsut, we will also stop by the colossal statues of Amenhotep III known as the <u>Colossi of Memnon</u>. Transfer to Luxor airport to take your flight back to Cairo and overnight in the Cairo hotel.
