Located in Luxor on the east bank of the Nile, <u>the Luxor Temple</u> is an amazing collection of ancient Egyptian temples. Its building was ordered by Amenhotep III to confirm that the god Amun was the one who owned it, as Egyptian customs had it that he was not eligible to take the throne. Furthermore, the temple would function as a focal point for the three Theban Triad members' worship.

# Day 5: West Bank of Luxor

The <u>Kom Ombo temple</u> was built during the reign of Ptolemy VI Philometor, but its exquisite decoration wasn't completed until the time of Emperor Tiberius. Local devotion to the place continues to this day.
