Day 1: Arrive Cairo, Optional Sound and Light Show in Giza Pyramids

Day 2: Giza Pyramids, Saqqara, Memphis

Giza Pyramids

Our first stop brings us face to face with the enigmatic <u>Giza Pyramids</u>, a testament to the incredible ingenuity and ambition of ancient Egyptian civilization. Rising majestically against the desert backdrop, the Great Pyramid of Giza, also known as the Pyramid of Khufu.

Saqqara

Continuing our expedition, we venture to <u>Saqqara</u>, an ancient burial ground that serves as a gateway to the afterlife. Here, the Step Pyramid of Djoser stands as an architectural marvel, a precursor to the grandeur of the Giza Pyramids. Also, you will visit the <u>tomb of Kagemni</u>, who was the first pharaoh of the sixth dynasty.

Memphis

Our final destination on this captivating journey takes us to <u>Memphis</u>, once the thriving capital of ancient Egypt. The remnants of this mighty city are a testament to its historical significance, with colossal statues, temples, and artifacts.

You will visit there, The <u>Sphinx of Memphis</u> is the largest Albastro sculpture ever built. Currently, the Alabaster Sphinx is on display in the open-air museum of Mit Rahina.

Day 3: Islamic Cairo, Coptic Cairo, Egyptian Museum

Your tour guide will accompany you for a fascinating city tour of Cairo after breakfast, beginning at the <u>Salah El Din Citadel</u>. With tours to Islamic Cairo, you can learn about the Islamic culture that has influenced Cairo for centuries while also visiting some of the most significant historical sites in the city.

Coptic Cairo

The journey then carries us to the serene enclaves of <u>Coptic Cairo</u>, a haven of tranquility amidst the bustling metropolis. This ancient Christian neighborhood cradles some of the oldest churches in Egypt, including the <u>Hanging Church</u> also known as the Suspended Church or the St. Virgin Mary's Coptic Orthodox Church.

at the end of the Coptic Cairo tour, you will discover <u>The church of St. Sergius</u> dates back to the 5th Century and is considered one of the most important churches and <u>things to do in Cairo</u>, although some historians believe that it was actually built in the 8th Century.

Enjoy a delicious lunch before exploring the market in <u>Khan El Khalili</u> in Cairo's downtown area. Al Hussein was the grandson of the Prophet of Islam, Mohamed (PBUH).

Egyptian Museum

Finally, we culminate our day of exploration at the renowned <u>Egyptian Museum</u>, an unparalleled repository of Egypt's ancient treasures. The museum's hallowed halls house an astonishing array of artifacts, from the glistening treasures of Tutankhamun.
