Day 1: Arrive Cairo, Check-In

When you arrive at <u>Cairo International Airport</u>, you will be greeted by a Cairo Top Tours representative and transferred to your Cairo hotel.

When you arrive, you will be given a welcome drink and assisted with smooth check-in procedures before your trip itinerary is revised with you to confirm all pick-up times.

Day 2: Giza Pyramids Tour, Saqqara Necropolis, Memphis City

After breakfast at your hotel, your tour guide will meet you in the lobby to begin your journey in Cairo.

Giza Pyramids Tour

Start your day by visiting the <u>Giza Pyramids</u>, one of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World. You can marvel at the majestic structures of the Great Pyramid of Khufu, the Pyramid of Khafre, and the Pyramid of Menkaure.

After that, head to <u>The Great Sphinx of Giza</u>, a statue of a man with a lion's body, can be seen on the Giza Plateau if you have the opportunity to ride a camel there.

Saqqara

Next, head to the <u>Saqqara Necropolis</u>, a vast burial site that contains many tombs and monuments from different dynasties.

You can explore <u>the Step Pyramid</u> of Djoser, the oldest stone-cut pyramid in Egypt, and learn about its architect, Imhotep. You can also visit the <u>Serapeum</u>, a subterranean complex that houses the sacred bulls of Apis.

you will visit the <u>pyramid of King Teti</u> from the sixth dynasty, and visit the <u>tomb of Kagemni</u>, who was the vizier of Justice during King Teti' reign.

Memphis City

Finally, end your day by visiting <u>Memphis</u> City, the ancient capital of Egypt. You can see the remains of the Temple of Ptah, the patron god of craftsmen and artisans. You can also admire the colossal statue of Ramses II, one of the most powerful pharaohs in history. You can also learn about the culture and history of Memphis at the Open-Air Museum.

Day 3: Egyptian Museum, Coptic Cairo Tour, Khan El-Khalili

Enjoy your breakfast at the hotel, then our representative will take you in a private car to discover most of Cairo's attractions.

Morning: Egyptian Museum

Start your day by visiting the Egyptian Museum, one of the most important antiquities museums in the world. You can spend half a day at the museum to enjoy the amazing artifacts and the huge statues of the Pharaohs. You can also see the treasures of Tutankhamun, including his famous gold mask, as well as the royal mummies of some of the most famous rulers of ancient Egypt.

Afternoon: Coptic tour

Next, head to <u>Coptic Cairo</u>, a part of Old Cairo that encompasses many historic churches, monasteries and monuments.

Visit the <u>Hanging Church</u>, one of the oldest and most beautiful churches in Egypt, built on top of the Roman gatehouse of the fortress.

You can also see the Greek <u>Church of St. George</u>, a round church with a distinctive dome and a relic of the saint.

Finally, end your day by visiting <u>Khan El-Khalili</u>, the most famous bazaar and souk in Cairo before return back to the hotel.
