Day 1: Arrival in Egypt

Your tour guide will greet you at the <u>Cairo International Airport</u>. He will assist you at the airport with the necessary tasks. Then he drives you to a luxurious, air-conditioned car where he will help you check into your hotel without incident. He will go over your 7-day itinerary with you after you check in so you can confirm the pick-up times for each tour and activity.

Overnight hotel stay in Cairo

Day 2: Cairo Day Tour to Sakkara and Dahshur Pyramids

The tour typically starts in the early morning after taking your breakfast from your accommodation in Cairo. Make sure you have comfortable clothing, sunscreen, water, and your camera ready.

The first destination is <u>Saqqara Necropolis</u>, which is located about 30 kilometers south of Cairo. The journey might take around 1 to 1.5 hours, depending on traffic.

This is one of the highlights of the Saqqara complex. The Step Pyramid is one of the earliest large-scale stone structures in Egypt, Continue your trip from our Egypt Tours Packages to another adjacent necropolis named Dahshur which is around 10 kilometers south of Saqqara. The drive should take about 30 minutes.

Dahshur is known for its unique pyramids, including the Red Pyramid which is one of the best-preserved pyramids in Egypt. You might also visit the Bent Pyramid, another distinct pyramid in Dahshur.

Before being brought back to your hotel as part of your <u>Cairo Day Tours</u>, lunch will be served at a nearby eatery.

Breakfast and Lunch

Day3: Old Cairo Tour

A Day 3 Old Cairo tour will take you through the historic heart of the city, where you'll encounter some of Cairo's most iconic and ancient sites.

Our tour guide will meet you at your hotel in Cairo or Giza to start your daily Cairo day excursions. <u>Salah El din Citadel</u> known as the Citadel of the Mountain and <u>Mosque of Muhammad Ali</u>, which for a while functioned as Egypt's capital.

During Egypt's Mamluk Islamic era, a sizable mosque and madrassa known as <u>Sultan Hassan Mosque</u>-Madrassa were constructed in the Old City of Cairo.

Bring you back to your hotel so you can rest there.

Breakfast and Lunch

Day4: Baharyia Oasis tour

After your delightful breakfast, we will take you to Bahariya Oasis is located in the Western Desert, about 365 kilometers southwest of Cairo. The journey will likely take around 4 to 5 hours by road, depending on traffic and road conditions.

Upon reaching <u>Bahariya Oasis</u>, you'll be greeted by your tour guide or local representative who will provide you with an overview of the day's activities.

Start your day with a traditional Egyptian lunch in the oasis then discover the fascinating Bahariya Oasis' distinctive flora and animals. This journey is a fantastic approach to discovering Egypt's allure and beauty.

Day 5: White Desert tour

After breakfast, you'll head into the White Desert, which is known for its surreal and otherworldly landscapes characterized by white limestone formations.

Your first stop might be at <u>Crystal Mountain</u>, a natural rock formation that appears to be studded with crystals, creating a sparkling effect, Next, a visit to the <u>Black Desert</u>, which is comprised of a variety of Black formations and mountains that are heavily covered in old volcanic rocks.

After that, you will have a visit to <u>Valley of El Haize</u>, the final settlement of Bahariya to the south, which is the next location we'll pass through. You can take a hot spring bath right here if you'd like.
