Visite la Presa Alta, una maravilla de la ingeniería que transformó el paisaje y proporcionó irrigación y electricidad vitales para la región. Descubra el obelisco inacabado, testimonio de las antiguas técnicas de extracción de los egipcios. A continuación, sumérjase en el ambiente sagrado del templo de Philae, dedicado a la diosa Isis. Para un final extraordinario, embáquese en una excursión a Abu Simbel, declarado Patrimonio de la Humanidad por la UNESCO. Admire los colosales templos construidos por Ramsés II y maravíllese ante sus intrincadas tallas y su conservación.

Itinerario

Day 1: Arrival in Cairo

With your name on a signboard, our tour guide will be waiting for you at [Cairo International Airport](#). You will ride in a contemporary, air-conditioned car as it takes you to the hotel in Cairo. In addition to helping you with check-in processes, our tour guide will go over the itinerary and Egypt's top attractions with you to confirm the time of pick-up for the tour of the [Giza pyramids](#) and the Egyptian Museum the next day.

Spend the night in the Cairo hotel.

Day 2: Giza Pyramids - Egyptian Museum Trip

You will meet our knowledgeable tour guide in the morning to be transferred to begin your seven-day Egypt holiday and see the Giza Pyramids, which are regarded as one of the most amazing structures ever created by a man. the Valley Temple of Chephren, where the mummification process was carried out, as well as the little pyramid of Mankurea. You can also see the Sphinx, which serves as the necropolis's watchdog, and the pyramids of Khufu, Chephren, and Mankurea.

The Egyptian Museum, the oldest archaeological museum in the Middle East, is where you'll see the best examples of Egyptian antiquities as well as the [Tutankhamen](#) collection. [The Egyptian Museum](#) is home to more than 170,000 objects.

You will be transferred to the hotel in Cairo at the conclusion of the journey there.

Day 3: Luxor East Bank Tour

After breakfast, you'll begin your journey to Cairo, Upper Egypt, to continue your seven-day trip through Egypt. You'll be taken to the Cairo airport to board a flight to Luxor, where you'll find our tour guide waiting to take you to your hotel and show you the temples of Luxor's East Bank after you've rested. The [Luxor Temple](#) was constructed by two kings, King Ramses II and King Amen.

Next, you will visit the [Karnak Temple](#), which was professionally related to the Luxor Temple and was devoted to the Thebes Amun, Mut, and Khunso trio. The tour guide will transport you to the hotel once you finish your lunch in the top-notch restaurant.

Day 4: Luxor West Bank - Optional Hot Air Balloon Ride

The [Valley of the Kings](#), the most well-known site in Luxor's West Bank, is situated in the middle of the tombs and is a treasure trove of archaeological wonders. In the morning, you will move to continue your trip to Cairo and Upper Egypt in a week. You will learn about these sites. Continue your 7-Day Egypt Vacation by visiting [Hatshepsut's Temple](#), which was designed by her engineer and is known as "El-dier el-Bahari."

You will see the Massive statue Stone of King Amenhotep, also known as "the [Colossi of Memnon](#)," after enjoying a fantastic meal in the high-class restaurant nearby.

Day 5: Kom Ombo & Edfu Temples

As soon as you wake up, check out of your Luxor hotel. We'll next go to [Edfu Temple](#), where you can view one of the best-preserved ancient Egyptian temples, the Temple of Horus, which is devoted to the falcon-headed god Horus.

You will continue your 7-day Egypt vacation after touring the Edfu temple by going to the [Kom Ombo Temple](#), which is a singular temple dedicated to two gods, Sobek and Haroeris, the Temple of Sobek, and where you can find out more about the ancient Egyptian god of crocodiles. You will then be taken to the nicest restaurant for lunch before checking in and spending the night at the hotel.

Day 6: Aswan: High Dam - Obelisk - Philae Temple

You're in for a treat on day 4 of your trip to Cairo and Upper Egypt in a Week! You'll be exploring the magnificent city of Aswan today. You start by going to [the High Dam](#), which is a truly amazing site and protects the nation from floods while also providing irrigation and hydroelectric power for the entirety of Egypt.

Following that, you'll go to the Isis-dedicated [Philae Temple](#). Visit the Unfinished Obelisk, too. This enormous granite obelisk was intended to be a component of a much larger monument, but it was never completed. once you

Day 7: Abu Simbel Temple, End of Service

You will visit the [Abu Simbel Temple](#) on the final day of your trip to Cairo and Upper Egypt, a week after taking a 7-day vacation in Egypt. The two temples of Abu Simbel were cut into the mountain rocks by King Ramses II of the nineteenth dynasty, who built these temples for himself and his favorite wife, Queen Nefertari. They are the last stop on your trip to Cairo and Upper Egypt a week after you spend a 7-Day Egypt vacation.
