Itinerary

Day tour from Safaga port to top Luxor attractions

"Cairo top tours" representative will pick you up from Safaga Port by the cruise exit door for 3 hrs drive to Luxor where you will start your day tour from Safaga to Luxor. Your tour guide will join you, The first stop

on the journey should be the Hatshepsut Temple at El Deir El Bahary. This magnificent temple honors Queen Hatshepsut, the only female pharaoh, and rises out of the desert plain in a series of terraces before blending into the surrounding steep limestone cliffs.

next travel to the Theben Necropolis on [the Nile River's west bank](#). Start your private trip to the Valley of the Queens, also known as Ta-Set-Neferu, which means "the land of beauty," and where wives and sons of pharaohs were interred. There are more than 90 known tombs, each with a sarcophagus chamber, a few small hallways, and an entry corridor. You will see three tombs of the Queens and sons of the Kings like the graves of Amun-her-khopesh, Seth-her-khopesh, Khaemwaset, and of a Ramesside Queen named Titi. The earliest may be that of Site, wife of Ramses I. The most renowned are those of Nefertari, Ramses II's preferred Queen.

At around noon you will have lunch in a local restaurant in Luxor

as a result, The Luxor Mummification Museum tour continues. This little museum, which initially welcomed visitors in 1997, displays instruments used in the mummification process as well as human and animal mummies. It also describes the practice of mummification, which the ancient Egyptians believed was necessary for obtaining eternal life. It also includes illustrations of the types of objects that were customarily buried with the dead.

You will be transported back to Safaga port after this amazing trip.
