Day 1 : Arrive Cairo - Start your Cairo, Oases and Nile Cruise Trip Package

Day 2: Giza Pyramids - Cairo Sightseeing Trip

After a delightful breakfast, you will be escorted to the Giza Plateau, home to the iconic landmarks of ancient Egypt. You will have the opportunity to marvel at the Great Pyramid of King Cheops, the Pyramid of Chephren, and the Pyramid of Mycerinus, all of which were constructed during the fourth dynasty between 2589 and 2504 B.C. Your licensed Egyptologist will provide you with fascinating information about the engineering marvels and the purpose behind these colossal structures.

You will then be brought to a vantage point on the high plateau, where you can take in the breathtaking panoramic view of the entire necropolis. Additionally, you may have the chance to enjoy an optional camel

ride, allowing you to experience the Giza Pyramids from a unique perspective.

Next, you will visit the renowned Sphinx, a mythical creature with the head of a human and the body of a lion, symbolizing strength and wisdom. You will also explore the Valley Temple, which was used for the purification of the king's mummy before burial, typically that of King Chephren.

Continuing your cultural immersion, you will explore the Egyptian Museum, one of the largest and most famous museums in the world, located in the heart of Cairo. Here, you will have the opportunity to marvel at the captivating artefacts and the stunning gold treasures of the young pharaoh, Tutankhamun.

In the afternoon, you will venture to the historic Coptic Cairo, where you will visit the Roman fortress of Babylon, the Hanging Church, the Church of St. Sergius and Bacchus, and the Ben Ezra Synagogue, one of the oldest historical sites revered by the Egyptian Jewish community.

Finally, you will be transported to the vibrant Islamic Cairo, where you will explore the renowned Khan El Khalili Bazaar, a bustling market that has been a significant part of Cairo's heritage for centuries.

After a day filled with immersive cultural experiences, you will be returned to your hotel for an overnight stay in Cairo.

Day 3: Cairo - Bahariya Oasis Tour

Check out from your Cairo hotel at 6:00 AM after breakfast, where you'll meet your expert guide to begin your Egypt Desert Safari journey. You'll travel in comfort by deluxe vehicle to the Bahariya Oasis, a drive of about four hours from Cairo. Upon arrival, your first stop will be the Museum of Golden Mummies, where you'll witness mummies adorned in gold. Next, you'll explore the Tombs of the Nobles, dating back to the 26th Dynasty, and visit the Temple of Alexander the Great. This temple features depictions of Alexander offering gifts to the god Amun-Re, a revered deity worshipped in Bahariya during the Greco-Roman period. The temple is believed to commemorate Alexander's journey through the Bahariya Oasis on his way to the Temple of the Oracle in Siwa Oasis.

You'll also visit the Temple of Meftella, located near Al-Qasr village, close to a spring that shares its name. Afterwards, enjoy a traditional Bedouin lunch in a Bedouin house, followed by some relaxation at your hotel's pool. Later in the day, you'll take a 4WD Jeep ride to ascend the Black Mountain, where you'll explore the ruins at the summit, known as the "English House," and take in a breathtaking panoramic view of Bahariya Oasis at sunset. Your day ends with an overnight stay in Bahariya.

Included Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner.

Day 4: White and Black Deserts Trip

After enjoying breakfast, head out to explore the salt lake and the surrounding dunes, taking in the lush palm trees and fruit orchards. Next, journey to the White Desert, located 170 km south of Bahariya. This stunning area is renowned for its vast white landscape, stretching across 3,010 square kilometres. The desert is distinguished by its large chalk formations and unique rock structures sculpted by ancient sandstorms.

As you travel, you'll pass through the Black Desert, known for its volcanic hills and darkened rocks, and the Valley of El Haize, which offers a refreshing breeze in Bahariya's southernmost village. Stop at Crystal

Mountain to admire its striking quartz crystals. This area, situated in Farafra Oasis, features impressive crystal formations and provides breathtaking views.

Continue to the Valley of Agabat, a realm of extraordinary beauty characterized by its surreal rock formations. Set up camp in the White Desert to marvel at the white limestone shapes, including formations resembling rabbits and mushrooms. End the day with a traditional Bedouin-style dinner under the stars.

Included Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner.

Day 5: Farafra Oasis - Dakhla Oasis Tour

Embark on another captivating day in the desert after breakfast at your camp. You'll journey to Farafra Oasis, a historic location mentioned in ancient Egyptian texts, situated approximately 170 km south of Bahariya, 360 km southwest of Marsa Matrouh, and 627 km from Cairo. Enjoy a relaxing dip in the hot springs of Bir Setah and explore the unique mud brick museum of local artist Badr, showcasing modern art.

Proceed to the old town of Al Qasr in Dakhla Oasis, an ancient archaeological site that served as a key transit point in antiquity. After a 3-hour drive from Farafra to Dakhla, visit the Roman Temple of Deir El Hagar. This small sandstone temple, dating back to Emperor Nero's reign, features inscriptions and carvings dedicated to gods like Amun, Mut, and Khonsu.

Explore the Roman burial site of Muzzawaqa, known for its beautifully carved rock-cut tombs. Following lunch, delve into the old Islamic village of Al Qasr, where ancient Roman ruins have been transformed into a charming town with narrow, covered streets, traditional houses, an old oil press, a wheat grinder, and a 12th-century mosque.

In the afternoon, unwind by the pool before venturing into Dakhla's stunning landscape. Enjoy the clear blue skies and golden dunes, and savour a Bedouin tea as you watch the sunset over the Great Sand Sea. Spend the night at a desert lodge perched on a cliff, offering views of the lush village nestled among the dunes and the beautiful pink-hued mountains of Dakhla Oasis.

Included Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner.

Day 6: Kharga Oasis Trip

Continue your desert adventure with a journey to Kharga Oasis, the largest of Egypt's oases and the capital of the New Valley Governorate, located 232 km south of Assiut. After enjoying your breakfast, you'll explore the area's rich history and attractions.

First, visit Qasr El Labkha, an ancient Roman fortress from the 5th century AD. Then head to the Kharga Museum, where you'll find artifacts from the Pharaonic, Ptolemaic, Roman, and Christian periods. Proceed to the Roman Temple of Hibis & Nadora, built during the reign of Emperor Antoninus Pius or Hadrian, located about 1 km north of Kharga. This temple is notable for its representation of various historical periods including Pharaonic, Persian, Ptolemaic, and Roman.

Next, explore Bagawat, an ancient cemetery known for its chapels adorned with biblical frescoes from the Old Testament, which have remarkably preserved their vibrant colours.

After a delicious lunch, travel to Baris Oasis, which dates back to 5000 BC and was dedicated to the Greek god Serapis. Visit the Temple of Dush, a Roman settlement that once served as a vital city along the trade route. Explore the remains of residential areas, the fortress dedicated to Isis and Serapis, and other features of this ancient settlement.

Conclude your day with an overnight camping experience amidst the golden dunes of Kharga Oasis.

Day 7: Luxor - East Bank Tours

After soaking in the beauty of Egypt's oases, it's time to delve into the rich history of Luxor!

You'll leave the desert behind and travel to Luxor, a 6-hour journey south of Cairo, approximately 670 km. Upon arrival, you'll board the luxurious 5-star Steigenberger MS Minerva Nile cruise. Check in, enjoy a delightful lunch, and then embark on your exploration of Luxor's East Bank.

Your first stop is the Karnak Temple Complex, a vast collection of temples, grand pillars, and ancient structures located just 3 km from Luxor. Known for its massive scale, Karnak is the largest religious structure ever constructed and served as the primary centre of worship for the deities Amun, Mut, and Khonsu. Continue your visit to the Temple of Luxor, renowned for its sandstone construction from Gebel el-Silsila, showcasing some of Egypt's most impressive architectural achievements.

Return to your cruise for dinner and an evening of entertainment, including a captivating music show, before spending the night onboard.

Day 8: Luxor West Bank Trip

Following breakfast on your Nile cruise, your guide will accompany you to Luxor's West Bank to explore the remarkable Colossi of Memnon, the grand statues of Amenhotep III. Next, you will visit the Valley of the Kings, located across the Nile from Luxor in the ancient city of Thebes. This renowned burial site is divided into eastern and western valleys and is famed for its elaborate rock-cut tombs of the Pharaohs.

Here, you can view the tombs of significant rulers, including the illustrious King Tutankhamun, who ruled Egypt until his untimely death at 19 (with an additional fee for this visit), and the formidable Ramses II, known for his epic Battle of Kadesh. The tombs are richly adorned with intricate paintings and filled with artefacts intended for the Pharaohs' afterlife.

Your tour will then continue to the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut, also known as El Deir El Bahary, dedicated to this prominent female ruler.

After lunch onboard, you will set sail towards Edfu, where you'll enjoy a leisurely dinner and spend the night aboard the Nile cruise.

Day 9: Edfu and Kom Ombo Temples Trip
