Day 1: Friday - Embarkation - Aswan Nile Cruise Tours

Our representative will greet and assist you upon arrival, and you will be escorted to boarding before lunch. You will enjoy a delicious lunch onboard the MS Royal Princess Nile Cruise, and then you will be transported to begin your Egypt Day Tours by a visit to the famous [high dam](#) in Aswan that contains 43,000,000 cubic meters of materials and it is about 4,000 meters long and 980m wide at the base and surprisingly about 11,000 cubic meters per second of water can pass through the dam through 180 sluice gates to regulate the flow of water to achieve flood control.

You will be transferred during the excursions in Aswan to the granite quarries used to provide the ancient Egyptians with the sufficient stone blocks used in building the impressive pyramids and temple, you will see the [Unfinished Obelisk](#) that is believed to be cut during the reign of the famous powerful Queen [Hatshepsut](#) during the [new kingdom](#) of ancient [Egypt history](#).

Then your driver and guide will take you to see one of the masterpieces of ancient Egypt during [Aswan day tours](#), Goddess [Isis](#) temple or the [Temple of Philae](#) then you will sail on the Nile then after you will have your afternoon tea then you will be greeted by the Captain's welcome cocktail after a full day of Aswan Excursions.

Day 2: Saturday - Kom Ombo and Edfu Temples

On your second day, you will have your breakfast aboard your [Egypt Nile River Cruise](#), then you will start the Tour to Kom Ombo and Edfu by sailing to Kom Ombo which is an unusual double temple in the town of Kom Ombo in Aswan Governorate, Upper Egypt. It was constructed during the Ptolemaic dynasty, 180–47 BC. Some additions to it were later made during the Roman period after you will explore an amazing temple shared by two deities of the region the crocodile-shaped god Sobek and Haroeris well-known as [Kom Ombo temple](#) after that you will sail to Edfu after that you will have your lunch aboard your Luxury Nile cruise Aswan to Luxor then you will be escorted to Visit [Edfu Temple](#) which was built during between 237 & 57 B.C., during the Ptolemaic period.

The temple of Edfu was dedicated to [Horus](#), the falcon-headed god. The Ancient Egyptians believed that the temple was built on the site where the great myth between the gods Horus and [Seth](#) took place then you will have your dinner served aboard the cruise ship after you will Sail to Esna to attend an Egyptian Galabeya Party, the 'Galabeya' is a type of [clothing in Egypt](#) that is a 1 piece long dress for men and women.

Day 3: Sunday - Luxor East Bank Tours

On your third day, you will have breakfast aboard the Nile cruise boat then you will be sailing to Luxor via Esna lock to enjoy [Luxor East Bank Tours](#), then you will have your lunch aboard the Nile cruise Aswan to Luxor, after that you can relax a little while having your afternoon tea after you will enjoy your [Luxor day tours](#) to visit [Luxor Temple](#).

built during the reign of the great builder and military conqueror [Amenophis the third](#) and the outer courtyard which is built during the [nineteenth dynasty](#), is known as the courtyard of [Ramesses II](#). It is 57 meters (188 feet) long and 51 meters (168 feet) wide then you will visit [Karnak Temple](#) after you will have your dinner aboard the 4 Days Nile River Cruise from Aswan To Luxor while enjoying a belly dancing show

Day 4: Monday - Disembarkation - Luxor West Bank Tours

You will start by having your breakfast aboard the cruise vessel then you will Check-out from Egypt Nile River Cruise then you will be transferred to start the [Luxor West Bank Tours](#) and choose three tombs to see from the inside in the Valley of the Kings and visit the magnificent Temple of Queen Hatshepsut (El-Deir El-Bahari Temple) after you are done, you will be transferred to continue [Luxor excursions](#) to the [Valley of the Kings](#) that contains the tomb of [Ramesses III](#) which is one of the largest and most visited tombs in the Valley of the Kings. The first unknown tomb since the discovery of [Tutankhamun](#)'s tomb & the [Temple of Queen Hatshepsut](#) (El-Deir El-Bahari).

Finally, you will stop to view the [Colossal statues of Memnon](#).
