Itinerary

Day 1: Arrive Cairo, Optional Nile Cruise Dinner

Upon your arrival at Cairo International Airport, our tour leader from Cairo Top Tours will meet you to assist with your transfer to the hotel and help you with the check-in process. They will also review the itinerary for your 6 Days Cairo and Hurghada Wheelchair Accessible Tour with you.

For this evening, you have the option to join a Cairo Nile dinner cruise. Enjoy a delightful buffet dinner while cruising the Nile River on a Nile cruise boat for one hour. The evening will be enhanced with traditional entertainment, including a belly dancing performance and a Tanoura dance show.

Day 2: Pyramids, Dahshur, Memphis

After enjoying your open-buffet breakfast at the hotel, you'll meet your tour guide who will accompany you on a fascinating Cairo day tour, visiting the Giza Pyramids, Dahshur, and Memphis.

Start your day with a tour of the Giza Pyramids, where you'll be amazed by these monumental structures built during Egypt's Old Kingdom by powerful pharaohs. These pyramids, constructed around 4500 years ago, stand as a testament to the ancient Egyptians' achievements, facilitated by the Nile River.

Explore the Great Pyramid of King Cheops, built using over 2.3 million limestone blocks to serve as his eternal resting place. Originally standing 146 metres high, each side measures 230 metres. From the high plateau, take in a panoramic view of the three pyramids: Cheops, Chephren, and Mycerinus. Chephren, Cheops' son, constructed his pyramid slightly smaller at 136 metres high, with some remnants of the outer casing still visible at the top.

Visit the Great Sphinx of Giza, a colossal statue with a lion's body and a human head, believed to have been created by Chephren. You'll also enter the Valley Temple, where the king's mummification was conducted as part of the burial rituals.

Next, travel to Memphis, the ancient capital of Egypt, now known as Mit Rahina. Explore the open-air museum featuring the second-largest alabaster sphinx and the colossal statue of King Ramses II, one of the most powerful pharaohs of the New Kingdom.

Continue to the Dahshur Archaeological Site to see the Bent Pyramid and the Red Pyramid, built for King Snefru, the founder of the 4th Dynasty and father of King Cheops. The Bent Pyramid is notable for its distinctive shape and well-preserved outer casing, while the Red Pyramid, distinguished by its reddish limestone, is considered the first true pyramid in Egyptian history.

Enjoy a gourmet lunch at a high-quality restaurant with views of the Giza Pyramids before returning to your hotel.

Day 3: Fly to Hurghada, Optional Hurghada Bedouin Desert Safari By Jeep

After breakfast, you'll be transferred to Cairo airport for your flight to Hurghada. Upon arrival at Hurghada airport, our representative will meet you and assist with your transfer to the hotel and check-in procedures. You'll have the rest of the day at your leisure to enjoy the hotel's pool and evening entertainment. Alternatively, you can opt for a Hurghada Bedouin Safari by Jeep at sunset or explore other activities from our selection of Hurghada excursions.

Explore the Hanging Church of the Holy Virgin Mary, built above the ruins of the Roman fortress of Babylon, and the Church of St Sergius (also known as the Cavern Church), which contains the well where the Holy Family sourced water during their refuge. You'll also visit the Ben Ezra Synagogue, which was originally a Coptic church before being converted into a Jewish synagogue.

After a delightful lunch at a quality restaurant, continue your Cairo day tours with a visit to the Egyptian Museum. Here, you'll see an extensive collection of ancient artifacts housed in a museum that has been showcasing Egypt's treasures since 1902.

Finally, head to the Khan El Khalili bazaar, Cairo's oldest market, for an exceptional shopping experience. You'll then be transferred to your hotel for check-in and overnight stay in Cairo.
