Day 1: Arrival, Giza Pyramids and Saqqara Necropolis

Upon arrival at Cairo International Airport, our representative will be waiting for you at the terminal to transfer you by private vehicle to your hotel in Giza. After checking in and leaving your luggage, you'll start your 3-Day Cairo Stopover Wheelchair Accessible tour package.

Begin your adventure by visiting the Pyramids of Giza, home to Egypt's most iconic pyramids. The Great Pyramid of King Cheops is a renowned symbol of Egypt and the last remaining ancient Wonder of the World. Constructed during the reign of the fourth dynasty King Khufu (2589-2566 BC), it took twenty years to build. You'll also have the option to enjoy a 1-hour camel ride at the Giza Pyramids.

Next, explore the Valley Temple of King Chephren and the Great Sphinx, a man-headed lion representing power and wisdom.

Afterward, travel to the Step Pyramid of King Djoser in Saqqara, a monumental structure from the 3rd dynasty, and the earliest large-scale stone building in Egypt. You'll have the chance to enter the Pyramid of Teti and visit the tomb of Kagemni, a nobleman from the 6th dynasty. Admire the intricate wall inscriptions depicting animals, fish, and birds in offering and hunting scenes, showcasing some of the finest art of ancient Egypt.

Return to the hotel after a delicious lunch at a local restaurant, check in, and enjoy your overnight stay in Cairo.

Day 2: Egyptian Museum, Coptic Cairo, Khan El Khalili Bazaar

After enjoying a delicious breakfast at the hotel, you'll meet your licensed tour guide to begin your fascinating Cairo city tour. Start with a visit to the Egyptian Museum in Tahrir Square, where you'll explore its remarkable collection of artifacts on a guided tour lasting approximately two hours. Highlights include the colossal statues of Ramses II, the golden mask, and the funerary treasures of King Tutankhamun, along with other priceless items.

Next, you'll be transferred to Old Cairo for a Coptic Cairo tour. Visit the Hanging Church, built atop the ruins of the Roman fortress of Babylon, and see the Church of St. Sergius, where the Holy Family is said to have sought refuge. Also, explore the Ben Ezra Synagogue, one of the oldest Jewish temples in the Middle East.

Enjoy a delicious lunch before heading to a renowned market in Islamic Cairo. The bazaar area is a major attraction, bustling with Egyptian craftsmen and workshops creating traditional crafts and souvenirs. Stroll through the market, enjoy a mint tea at a local café, or simply wander to admire the stunning Islamic architecture.

After your day of excursions, return to the hotel for an overnight stay in Cairo.
