Day 1: White desert tour

To begin your journey in the white desert, you will be picked up from your Cairo hotel on the first day of your vacation and driven all the way to the Bahrayia oasis in an air-conditioned vehicle.

The white desert

The reserve is home to a variety of unique and endangered wild creatures, including the Moorish ram and white deer, as well as several desert trees and numerous fossils that date back millions of years.

El Haiz Valley:

This was discovered on the remains of the Roman stronghold, one of the Western Desert's most northern garrisons.

Mountain of crystal;

It lies in the White Desert, 160 kilometers from the Bahariya Oasis and 120 kilometers from the Farafra Oasis. Because it is a massive mountain mass of various crystal ores—more than 12 different varieties of crystal—it is regarded as one of the rarest mountains in the world.

Agabat Valley:

Located in Egypt's Western Desert, Agabat, also referred to as the "Beautiful Valley," is frequently visited by visitors en route to Bahariya and the White/Black Deserts.

You will be driven all the way to the Sandrose Hotel at the end to spend the night there.

Day meals: dinner and lunch.

Day 2: Last day tour

After breakfast on the second day of your tour, you will be picked up from the hotel to begin the day's activities.

The Hall of the Golden Mummies:

The first tomb in this enormous cemetery, which contained the gold-covered mummies of men, women, and children, was accidentally discovered by Sheikh Abdel Mawgod, the guard of the Temple of Alexander the Great, whose donkey stumbled into a hole next to the temple.

The Nobles' Tombs:

These have been repurposed for collective graves, such as the tombs of Zed-Amun-Ef-Ankh and Bannentiu, and that have much to reveal about the mysteries of the ancient rulers of the oasis.

Ain El-Meffetla Temple:

near Bawiti's northwest. Egyptian experts discovered the temple's four chapels, which date back to the 26th dynasty of ancient Egypt, in 1939.

Lake Salt:

Because Great Salt Lake lacks an outlet, it is salty. Small amounts of salt are continuously introduced by tributary rivers as dissolved salt in their freshwater flow. The salt remains in the Great Salt Lake after a large portion of the water evaporates.

Fruit and palm gardens This will be your final destination before you are driven back to Cairo for your drop-off point, which will mark the conclusion of our service.
