## Day 1: Fly from Hurghada to Cairo

For this particular day, in the morning, a vehicle will be arranged to pick you up from your lodging in Hurghada and take you to Catch your flight to Cairo from Hurghada airport. Once you land at Cairo airport, our qualified Egyptologist will welcome you him/her and organize a city tour which will cover the Giza pyramids as well as the Egyptian Museum. It is also recommended that you bring with you lightweight attire white cotton clothes with sleeves' to shield yourself from the sun as well as seek comfort.

Compared to other tours which might be too tall the bus will carry you to the Giza plateau upon your arrival in Cairo. Thus hits this page of Ancient Wonder where introductory speeches regarding the construction of the Great Pyramid (of the main The Great Pyramid of Giza), the Middle Pyramid, and the Small Pyramid are given. They will tell you how it was built and what was its role in ancient Egyptian society.

After that, the tour continues to the Giza Sphinx – a lion-headed statue, which has a man's face and is over 4000 years old. It will be followed by a figure walk to the Valley Temple and then a categorical visit to the Great Pyramid where a professional guide will give a short excursion in the pyramid. Next, light snacks will be served in the local café, and you will take the bus back to your hotel.

The left time of the first day will be devoted to the visit of the Egyptian Museum in Tahrir Square. In the evening you will be driven to Cairo airport for a flight to Luxor and then meet our representative and transfer to the hotel for overnight there.

### Day 2: Luxor day tour - End of your trip from Hurghada

On this date, breakfast will be offered and the guests are expected to checkout. After that, you will dress up and get ready to enjoy more of the beautiful Luxor which has a tour guide professionally who will also take you to temples and tombs constructed by the ancient Egyptians thousands of years ago.

In the same way, we will begin this day tour, by driving towards the city and getting to the first stop of the trip, the valley of the Kings where tombs of Egyptian kings and queens are located. The Hatshepsut temple stands magnificently as a monumental piece that was erected for the mighty queen Hatshepsut who also ruled during the 18th dynasty of Egypt. Since this is one of the major historical sites in Egypt, we will make it a point to give you a little more than enough time here because we know you would want to look around.

With all that history then we will also go to Hatshepsut temple which is another fine building erected by one of the fiercest women pharaohs of Egypt. Next, it is off to the Colossi of Memnon with its enticing sound, (do try to hear it at noon!).

And in the end, Timber Lake, who concluded isn't it amazing how u astounded you after taking pictures in the reconstructed Bracebridge emperor's house, having amazing old pillars in Karnak aside from a towering ceiling in the splendor of the inn clear sky, pyramids, temples and other enticing structures that are found in brink strang their bald and elongated heads.
