### Day 1 - Luxor east and west banks Tour

When you arrive, a tour guide will meet you and give you a tour of Luxor, which is well-known for its several significant temples.

First, tour the east bank where you will visit the Luxor Temple which was constructed during the period of Amenhotep iii, where after you finish the visit, the tour guide will take you to the temple of Karnak, which happens to be the greatest religious temple ever built by mankind and was also the cultic and administrative center during the new kingdom. Explore the background of Luxor Temple as this temple was joined by a procession aisle with that of Karnak Temple which was constructed under the reign of Amenhotep || and finished by Ramses || who happens to be the person who also built the outer part.

Then, head to the west bank to explore Deir Al-Bahari Temple of Queen Hatshepsut constructed in the years 2061-2010 BC during the reign of Queen Hatshepsut which is popularly known as El-Deir El-Bahari, and has the queen's majesty divine birth story written on it. take a trip to the Valley of the Kings where the tomb of King Tutankhamun and many other New Kingdom Pharaohs lie, more than 60 tombs built into cliffs have been found.

you may proceed for a trip to the Colossi of Memnon, and view two huge stone figures in the position of a sitting pharaoh Amenhotep III, colossuses of king Amenhotep III that are the only ones that survived from his magnificent hall.

### day 2 - Abu Simbel Tour

Enjoy an amazing day tour to Abu Simbel temples where you will cover the famous temples of Abu Simbel that are among the best art treasures of ancient Egyptian civilization. These two imposing temples, carved out of the rocks by King Ramses II, were dedicated to Ramses II and his condescending spouse, Queen Nefertari. The temples are famous because of their intact wall paintings painted in bright colors and depicting some of the important wars that took place during the reign of Ramses II.
