Day 1: Transfer to Luxor

The first day commences when a certified tour guide from Cairo Top Tours picks you up to some of the sites located in the southern part of Egypt. Later, you will travel by sedan cabs since you will have arrived in Luxor straight from Marsa Alam.

The expedition starts with a brief visit to the famous Valley of the Kings, known for its royal tombs. The tombs contain fascinating ancient wall paintings which have enjoyed many centuries without losing their amazing colors. You will discover the long history and significance of these tomb places.

Then you will proceed to the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut, a temple that boasts of an interesting design. The temple, under the Queen Nefertiti, who was a powerful dynasty of Egypt, building has no other temple found in the eastern side of Thebes of the Nile river.

Following this, the tour will proceed to the Colossi of Memnon; the two giant broken statues which remain from a temple once belonging to King Amenhotep III. The statues depict the immersed figure of king Amenhotep III, his wife Tiye and his mother, Mutemwia.

When you are finished with these astonishing sites, you will have a local lunch, before heading underneath the last attraction for that day, the Temple of Karnak. This enormous temple complex, which is built to Amun Ra, was the most extensive religious architecture in ancient history.

Cap the day by unwinding and spending the night in a hotel in Luxor, one of the famous cities in Egypt.

Day 2: Travel to Cairo

As you begin to feel at ease on the second day, brace yourself for a thrilling excursion to some of the popular tourist sites in Cairo and if time permits, go for some shopping. After breakfast, your journey continues with your flying from Luxor to Cairo.

Visiting Great Pyramids Of Giza

Start by going on an excursion to Great Pyramids of Giza, which is currently regarded as one of the seven wonders of the world. So far no one has come up with concrete reasons on how these huge creations came into existence. The most remarkable of these pyramids is that of Khufu, the largest and the most fascinating one. This house design preserves the good spirit of the Pharaoh Khufu's in the afterlife for the purpose of the pyramids' construction.

The Great Sphinx

The Great Sphinx, allied as lions created with human brains holding a monstrous figure, the statue is the head of the lion positioned facing the river on one side and human brain structure on the other. At some point he was believed to be the great deity protecting the plateau from the intruders, who would defile the place.

The Valley Temple

Next you will continue and explore the Valley Temple, which is located within the complex of the funerary temple of Pharaoh Khafre. This built-out compact disk installation was part of a practice that turned an corpse into a dead king in the form of eternal mummification.

Lunch Break

The Egyptian Museum

Lastly, you shall also go to The Egyptian Museum which contains more splendid items from ancient Egypt including that of the boy King Tut and many other treasures. This shall be easy since the guests shall be driven around by our very expert guide.
